## SPRING 2013 GIRLS FAST-PITCH SOFTBALL DETAILS

REGISTRATION:	February 1 <sup>st</sup> – February 22 <sup>nd</sup> Register by mail* or ONLINE at www.bvgsa.org * If mailed, your entry form must be postmarked by Friday, Feb. 22 <sup>nd</sup> . * Send entry form to: BVGSA, PO BOX 9797, College Station, TX 77842. * Being a resident of College Station is not a requirement to participate. Registration forms must be accompanied with the entry fee.
FEE:	\$60 for the entry fee paid by Visa, MasterCard, Discover, or check payable to the BVGSA.
AGE LIMIT:	5 –12 years old; Eligible birth years: 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008.
SEASON:	Practices begin March 4 <sup>th</sup> . Opening ceremonies and games begin Monday, March 25 <sup>th</sup> . The season could last to the end of May. Special game day and team picture day will be on a Saturday.
LEAGUE FORMAT:	Girls will be assigned to teams in age groups 6U, 8U, 10U or 12U. All teams will be scheduled to play 10 games. Awards will be provided to all participants.
LOCATION:	All games will be held at facilities maintained by the City of College Station. Central Park will serve as our primary facilities. <b>Concessions will be available during games</b> .
GAME TIMES:	Games will be scheduled for 6:00 p.m. and 7:10 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. All divisions will play at both game times. Other days and times may be used if necessary to complete the season. There will be a Saturday, with a special game day and team picture day.
CANCELLATIONS:	To find out if a scheduled game or practice has been canceled or postponed due to inclement weather, visit <u>cstx.gov/sports</u> . Whenever possible, games canceled due to weather or poor field conditions will be rescheduled.
PRACTICE TIMES:	BVGSA will schedule practice times and game times to help facilitate field availability. Coaches will notify the player at the beginning of the season.
PLAYING TIME:	The philosophy of this program is to offer a recreational activity that allows all girls to participate in and to learn the fundamentals of softball. There is unlimited substitution and all players bat.
UNIFORM:	T-shirts are provided to players and coaches.
TEAM PLACEMENT & COACH INFO:	<ul> <li>The teams will be created under an evaluation/draft system and the players will be selected by the coaches, except for our 6U division. Head coaches will be selected by the BVGSA and contacted by Monday, Feb. 25. Coaches and players in the 8U, 10U and 12U divisions will come to the Central Park Softball Complex for player evaluations on Tuesday, Feb. 26.</li> <li>8U players will be on Field 3 beginning at 6:00 p.m.</li> <li>10U players will be on Field 4 beginning at 6:00 p.m.</li> <li>12U players will be on Field 2 beginning at 6:00 p.m.</li> <li>Players need to bring their softball equipment (glove, shoes, bat, etc.) to be evaluated. All coaches need to meet at 2<sup>nd</sup> base of Field 1 at 5:40 p.m. before evaluations begin.</li> </ul>
	Players will be able to leave once they are evaluated, except pitchers in the 10U and 12U divisions. Coaches should plan to be at the fields for about two and a half hours.

Evaluated skills are as follows:

	Each player will hit balls from home plate, then move to the short stop position to field and throw balls, and then move to first base to catch balls from the next evaluated player. All pitchers will pitch balls from the rubber to their own catcher at the end of the hitting, fielding, throwing, and catching portion of the evaluation.

TEAM COACH:	Each team is coached by a parent and non-parent volunteers. All other volunteer coaches will be selected and contacted by the head coaches (except 6U, assistant coaches will be placed on a team). All parent coaches will be with their daughter.
	If you signed up to be an assistant volunteer coach and do not get contacted by Tuesday, Feb. 26 <sup>th</sup> , then contact the BVGSA @ bvgsa@rocketmail.com. Coaches undergo a background check and head coaches are asked to attend all coaches' meetings.
