

The T-Ball Division is for 5 & 6 year old players. It is a non-competitive league with no scores or standings - Just FUN!! The goals are to learn about basic baseball skills and to enjoy team play. This introduction is a great start to Little League! There is usually 1 game per week, and 1 or more practices. The season will conclude just after the  $4^{th}$  of July weekend with each team's final game being played on the Majors field followed by an award ceremony.

The "A" Division is for 7 & 8 year old players, many of whom are experiencing organized baseball for the first time. NOTE: Advanced 6 year old players who have completed one year of T-Ball may move up to the "A" Division with league approval. This is a "coach pitch" league with the purpose of providing a fun atmosphere to experience some competitive play, along with the necessary instruction for each player to continue developing their individual skills. This division provides equal playing time for all players as well as the opportunity to play different positions in the field. Everyone is in the batting lineup and the game is played with regular baseball rules with some modifications. Although the games are scored-league standings are not kept. There are usually 2 games per week, along with 1 or more practices. The regular season will end just before the 4<sup>th</sup> of July weekend with each player receiving a participation award. All teams return after the break to compete in a double elimination tournament with trophies being awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

The "AA" Division is for 9 year olds, and the 10 year old players that not selected to play in the "AAA" division or did not attend "Player Evaluations". NOTE: Advanced 8 year old players may move up to the "AA" division with league approval. This division has been designed to help the players adjust to "live" pitching. Emphasis is placed on teaching the fundamental skills of baseball and teamwork. Players will generally be in the field for 12 defensive outs per game and everyone is in the batting lineup. There are usually 2 games per week, and 2 or more practices. All teams return after the 4<sup>th</sup> of July break to compete in a double elimination tournament with trophies being awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Players in this division are not eligible for District/State Post-Season Tournament teams.

The "AAA" Division is for 10 year olds who tryout and are selected, the 11 & 12 year old players who are not selected to play in the Majors division or did not attend the "Player Evaluations". NOTE: Advanced 9 year olds may also tryout for "AAA" This league is focused on continuing to develop the individual skills needed to advance to the Majors division. Players are guaranteed to be in the field for at least 9 defensive outs per game and everyone is in the batting lineup. The regular season schedule may include inter-league games with other Little League programs. There are usually 2-3 games per week (potential 8pm night games) and 2 or more practices. The season will conclude just before the 4<sup>th</sup> of July weekend with all teams participating in the All City Inter-League Tournament. Only the 9 & 10 year olds in this division are eligible for District/State Post-Season Tournament teams.

The Majors Division is the highest level of Little League play. Teams are selected through a draft process. Players must attend the "Player Evaluations" to be eligible for the draft. This division is for sufficiently skilled 10-12 year old players. Roster size is limited to 12 players per team. Players are guaranteed to be in the field for at least 6 defensive outs and have 1 at-bat per game. Playing time beyond this is earned and decided by the head coach. The regular season schedule may include inter-league games with other Little League programs. There are usually 2-3 games per week (potential 8pm night games) and 3 or more practices. The regular season will conclude just before the 4<sup>th</sup> of July weekend with all teams participating in the All City Inter-League Tournament. Each team will also have the opportunity to play in a post season tournament against other teams in the district with a similar record. All Players in this division are eligible for District/State Post-Season Tournament teams.
