*All leagues accepting players 5 years of age must be 5 on April 30th, 2010. **Parents of new players** must provide a copy of a birth certificate to verify age and proof of residency, such as a drivers license or current utility bill. Due to new Little League rules **all returning players** must have their residency verified. We will be asking for a driver's license or current utility bill when your child registers.

The T-Ball Division is for 5 & 6 year old players. It is a non-competitive league with no scores or standings - Just FUN!! The goals are to learn about basic baseball skills and to enjoy team play. This introduction is a great start to Little League! There is usually 1 game per week, and 1 or more practices. The season will conclude just after the 4th of July weekend with each team's final game being played on the Majors field followed by an award ceremony.

The "A" Division is for 7 & 8 year old players, many of whom are experiencing organized baseball for the first time. **NOTE:** Advanced 6 year old players who have completed one year of T-Ball may move up to the "A" Division with league approval. This is a "coach pitch" league with the purpose of providing a fun atmosphere to experience some competitive play, along with the necessary instruction for each player to continue developing their individual skills. This division provides equal playing time for all players as well as the opportunity to play different positions in the field. Everyone is in the batting lineup and the game is played with regular baseball rules with some modifications. Although the games are scored- league standings are not kept. There are usually 2 games per week, along with 1 or more practices. The regular season will end just before the 4th of July weekend with each player receiving a participation award. All teams return after the break to compete in a double elimination tournament with trophies being awarded for 1st 2nd and 3rd place.

The "AA" Division is for 9 year olds, and the 10 year old players that not selected to play in the "AAA" division or did not attend "Player Evaluations". **NOTE:** Advanced 8 year old players may move up to the "AA" division with league approval. This division has been designed to help the players adjust to "live" pitching. Emphasis is placed on teaching the fundamental skills of baseball and teamwork. Players will generally be in the field for 12 defensive outs per game and everyone is in the batting lineup. There are usually 2 games per week, and 2 or more practices. All teams return after the 4th of July break to compete in a double elimination tournament with trophies being awarded for 1st 2nd and 3rd place. Players in this division are not eligible for District/State Post-Season Tournament teams.

The "AAA" Division is for 10 year olds who tryout and are selected, the 11 & 12 year old players who are not selected to play in the Majors division or did not attend the "Player Evaluations". **NOTE:** Advanced 9 year olds may also tryout for "AAA" This league is focused on continuing to develop the individual skills needed to advance to the Majors division. Players are guaranteed to be in the field for at least 9 defensive outs per game and everyone is in the batting lineup. The regular season schedule may include inter-league games with other Little League programs. There are usually 2-3 games per week (potential 8pm night games) and 2 or more practices. The season will conclude just before the 4th of July weekend with all teams participating in the All City Inter-League Tournament. Only the 9 & 10 year olds in this division are eligible for District/State Post-Season Tournament teams.

The Majors Division is the highest level of Little League play. Teams are selected through a draft process. Players must attend the "Player Evaluations" to be eligible for the draft. This division is for sufficiently skilled 10-12 year old players. Roster size is limited to 12 players per team. Players are guaranteed to be in the field for at least 6 defensive outs and have 1 at-bat per game. Playing time beyond this is earned and decided by the head coach. The regular season schedule may include inter-league games with other Little League programs. There are usually 2-3 games per week (potential 8pm night games) and 3 or more practices. The regular season will conclude just before the 4th of July weekend with all teams participating in the All City Inter-League Tournament. Each team will also have the opportunity to play in a post season tournament against other teams in the district with a similar record. All Players in this division are eligible for District/State Post-Season Tournament teams.

Placement of all players is subject to approval of the Player Agent

1. I/We, the parents/guardians of the above-named candidate for a position on a Little League team, hereby give my/our approval to participate in any and all Little League activities, including transportation to and from the activities.

2. I/We know that participation in baseball or softball may result in serious injuries and protective equipment does not prevent all injuries to players, and do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify, and agree to hold harmless the local Little League, Little League Baseball, Incorporated, the organizers, sponsors, supervisors, participants, and persons transporting my/our child to and from activities from any claim arising out of any injury to my/our child whether the result of negligence or for any other cause.

3. I/We agree to return upon request the uniform and other equipment issued to my/our child in as good conditions as when received except for normal wear and tear.

4. I/We agree that our child (candidate) may be required to try out for a team. If such does not attend at least 50 percent of the tryouts, local Board-of-Directors' approval is required for such candidate to be placed on a team.

5. I/We understand that our child (candidate) may be chosen at anytime to play on a Major Division team, if he or she is of the correct age for such division as determined by the local league and Little League Baseball. Declining to move up to such Major Division team will result in forfeiture of eligibility for the Major Division for the current season, and may be subject to further restrictions by the local league.

6. I/We agree to provide proof of legal residence (as defined by Little League Baseball, Incorporated) and age. I/We understand that our child (candidate) must be eligible under the residence and age regulations of Little League Baseball, Incorporated, to participate in this Local League, and that if any controversy arises regarding residence and/or age, the decision of the Charter Committee in Williamsport shall be final and binding. I/We further understand that if any participant on a Little League team does not qualify for participation in the league based on residence (as defined by Little League Baseball, Incorporated) and/or age, such participant and/or team on which he/she participates be found ineligible, and forfeit(s) and/or suspension of Tournament privileges may be decreed by action of the Charter Committee or Tournament Committee.

7. I/We will furnish a certified birth certificate of the above-named candidate to League Officials.
