

SAMPLE AFFIDAVIT OF INTENT TO BECOME A PERMANENT RESIDENT

Below is a sample of the Affidavit of Intent to Become a Permanent Resident. Note that some institutions also refer to this document as the Residency Affidavit. Students will need an original notarized copy for each institution they are applying to. Note also that some institutions may require students to fill in some supplemental documentation for their internal purposes.

Some institutions will prefer that students use an Affidavit of Intent that they will provide on their institutional letterhead. In the Rio Grande Valley, the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley, South Texas College, and Texas Southmost College each have a unique Affidavit of Intent. Blank copies of these affidavits can be found in the pages that follow. Texas State Technical College in Harlingen uses the standard form provided by the state, found on page 15.
