- 1) BJA contest rules will be operative throughout the event. All other regulations regarding the event will be in accordance with BJA Tournament Handbook.
- 2) Modified contest rules will be used for Groups 1 & 2 (u12 Contest Rules)
- 3) You understand and agree that neither the Organisers of the event nor the BJA (nor any of its Officials or members) shall be liable or responsible for any personal injury or for any loss or damage to property arising out of participation and travelling in connection with this Competition.
- 4) Medallists must wear White Judogi during the medal presentation
- 5) Competitors must wear suitable footwear at all times when off the mat
- 6) UK judoka only: Points Scoring: Youth, Seniors & Veterans were appropriate
- 7) **BLUE GIS:** Groups 5 11 (incl.) only: Second player called for a contest has the option (not mandatory) of wearing a Blue or White suit. Players choosing to wear a White suit must wear a blue belt. Players choosing to wear a blue suit must wear their grade belt. Players must provide their own belts.
- 8) **DOUBLE ENTRIES:** Players may, if eligible, enter both Junior and Youth or Senior and Youth or Senior and Veterans. This is called a double entry. See entry fees.
- 9) If there are insufficient entries in a weight group the organiser of the event reserves the right to combine weight groups after consultation with the appropriate competitors
- 10) Any rules incorporated after the issue of this entry form will also apply.
- 11) Event organisers have the right to refuse entry without explanation. In this case applicant will be notified.

The entry will close when maximum entries, i.e. 450 each day, have been received even if this is before the stated closing date.

Coaches/ Managers:

Each club will be given one free Coach Pass for every 3 Judokas in competition on that particular day. <u>Additional coach passes will be charged at £5 per day</u>, to be payable at entrance. Coaches will be asked to register at the door on the day. Coaches will need to show their coach accreditation or identification document! No accreditation, no pass!!

Coach Trophy:

Each coach that participates has a chance of winning the coach trophy. There will be a trophy for Seniors (Groups 6 & 7) and one for Veterans (Groups 8, 9, 10 & 11). Coaches that want to be considered for this trophy are advised to indicate this clearly on the entry form by ticking relevant box behind their name. Coach pass will be required as proof of coach qualification. There is no additional charge. Winner will be decided as follows: 1. Medal Winner (any colour), 2. Total wins, 3. Points scored. This means that a coach who won a Bronze medal and won 3 contests will win over a coach who got a Gold medal, but only won 2 contests.

Start Numbers:

Start numbers will be issued to each competitor and will be sent to entrants from end of September 2014 onwards.

Incorrect details or missing info will result in start number not being sent out or sent to incorrect address.
