  - 3. Two additional genres (types of writing or representations) connected to your tree. Possible genres include: poem, song, letter, poster, mural, map, diorama (with written explanation), advertisement, interview (real or imagined), radio broadcast, graphs, charts, wanted poster, diary or journal entry, comic strip (at least six frames), mosaic, collage, narrative essay, newspaper article, brochure, eulogy, persuasive essay, obituary, and descriptive narrative. These are only a few possibilities. If you come up with one of your own, please submit your idea to your teacher for approval.
