Father Robert Barron returns for another series on the Catholic Church

In 2012 St. Bede hosted a 10-session series entitled "CATHOLICISM" which was narrated by Father Robert Barron, the current rector of the University of St. Mary of the Lake, the Archdiocesan seminary. These sessions were well attended and the comments that followed were very positive.

Beginning Wednesday, May 14th we will again host a series developed by Father Barron. This multimedia program is titled "<u>CATHOLICISM:</u> The New Evangelization". The "New Evangelization" demonstrates how to put faith into action in today's increasingly secular world. It examines the factors that have created our secularized culture, and outlines steps to take for Catholics who want to share their Faith with others. The series focuses on the challenges the Church faces today, such as "the new atheism" and relativistic attitudes toward questions of faith and morality.

"While the content of the Apostolic Faith remains the same, all Catholics are called to share it with new ardor, new expressions and new methods," said Father Barron.

As with the original "CATHOLICISM" program the format for the sessions will include a video presentation and group discussion. In addition, a "Study Guide" is utilized so that participants may pray and prepare for each session.

We will be presenting this program in Coleman Hall at both 1:00 PM and 7:00 PM for 6 consecutive Wednesdays, starting on May 14th.

We had such an excellent response to the first series I pray we will all have that same enthusiasm for Father Barron's second series.
