3. Who to serve with:

(Please note: Jobs for which the students is paid are NOT approved hours. No “double dipping” the service hours done for the school cannot fulfill another service requirement.)

4. Service for the school
- a. Freshman MUST have a minimum of 5 hours (half of their required service) dedicated to Pope John Paul II HS school. Community Service Corp does count for freshman service hours CSC only counts for freshman.
 - b. Sophomore, Juniors, and Senior service hours that can apply to the school are limited.
 - i. Sophomores no more than 6 hours
 - ii. Juniors no more than 8 hours
 - iii. Seniors no more than 10 hours
5. **The due day is March 8, 2013**, service hours with completed reflection questions .
6. Failure to complete service hours will result in failure on the 3rd quarter.
- a. An unsatisfactory grade in Christian Service will prevent students from receiving honors.
 - b. An unsatisfactory grade in Christian Service, along with another academic failure, will result in the student not being allowed to participate in school sports or any school activity.
7. Seniors, the service requirement must be completed in order to graduate. Underclass failure to complete service hours will be carried over to the next school year. No student will graduate until they complete their Christian Service Hours.

9. Complete the reflection questions on the form provided.
