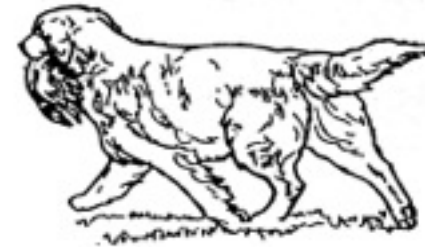

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretaries and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing, by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagle (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

Entry Fee: TD-\$60.00, TDX-\$120 (Includes AKC Recording Fee and AKC Event Services fee of \$3.50) Effective for events held on or after January 1, 2008, the American Kennel Club (AKC) will collect a \$3.50 AKC Event fee and recording fee for the first entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. A show giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all recording fees and Event Servicing fees for the AKC. The fact shall be stated in the premium list. These recording and event servicing fees shall be forwarded to the AKC along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event. (AKC rule Ch.11 Sec. 2)

An original certification of a non-TD dog's ability to track, provided by an AKC tracking judge, must be submitted with the entry form in order to enter a Tracking Dog test. Certification is valid for one year.

Entries which pass an AKC approved test after the closing date of this test may withdraw from this test with full refund provided the test secretary is notified in writing not less than three days before the test date and there is an alternate to replace the entry.

In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test secretary to determine if any alternates are present and decide according to their previous assigned position on the alternate list which of such entries shall participate.

The TD Test will begin with the drawing for tracks at 7:45 AM, at the test Headquarters. The TDX Test will begin with the drawing for tracks at 9:30 AM, at the test Headquarters.

Bitches in season may participate. (Ch. 2, Sec. 8). Other breeds, in addition to Golden Retrievers, may participate. (Ch.1 Sec. 13) If the limit for entries is not reached in one test, and is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks may be exchanged according to AKC Regulations. (Ch 1, Sec. 15)

Trophies: Each dog passing the TD or TDX test will receive a green qualifying rosette.

Directions:
From the East on I-94:

Take exit #136, M-60 South. Go through the town of Spring Arbor. Continue for another 5 miles. Terri and Bill's house is on the left side of the road. Look for the Marshbanks tracking signs. If you get to Concord Rd. you have gone too far.

From the West on I-94:

Take exit #127 (Concord Rd.). Go south until the road ends at M-60. Turn left. The driveway will be on the right about ¼ mile (first house on the right).
