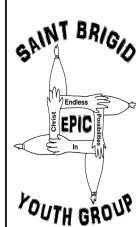

FASTING and ABSTINENCE during LENT:

ABSTINENCE from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years of age and older on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent.

FASTING is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are allowed as needed, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Exceptions being those persons who are ill or have other medical conditions.



The St. Brigid of Kildare Knights of Columbus is pleased to announce the St. Brigid of Kildare Knights of Columbus Scholarship. This post-secondary scholarship is for a maximum of \$2,000 to be paid out in yearly increments of \$500 as requirements are maintained.
