




# 2015 Accountability Leadership Institute for English Learners and Immigrant Students







### State Seal of Biliteracy The First in the Nation






## Number of Participating Agencies




### "Augmentation" to ELD Standards for Math and Science






# LEA Plan Requirement for Funding

#### Per Title III, Section 3114(a):


for a fiscal year, eligible local educational agencies (LEAs) must have a plan in accordance with Title III Section 3116 to receive Title III Funding (Limited English Proficient & Immigrant)

- LEAs shall describe programs and activities proposed to be developed, implemented and administered under the subgrant
- Plan shall describe how the LEA will use subgrant funds to meet all annual measurable objectives




# LEA Plan Requirement for Funding

- CDE conducted the review of LEA Plan Goal 2 on July 27–31
- The review established the list of LEAs eligible for timely release of Title III funds
- Title III funds were released to LEAs that had a substantially approvable plan



### **Substantially Approvable**

- Substantially approvable means the plan generally:
  - Contained no hidden administrative costs budgeted in the allocation to the activities
  - Had no indications of supplanting the general (LCFF) funds or other federal funding sources
  - Identified allowable activities under Title III designed to meet AMAOs
  - Addressed all required activities
  - Allocated all projected funds




### **Eligibility Status**

- CDE sent LEAs the eligibility and funding notifications via e-mail in July 2015

### 2015–16 Application


- Applications for LEP and Immigrant funding for 2015–16 were due June 30, 2015
- Consortia Applications were due August 27, 2015
- CDE will continue considering late applicants until March 30, 2016



### 2014–15 Subgrantee Awards


 2014–15 funding application closed on March 31, 2015, and per pupil amounts for both LEP and Immigrant have been revised and finalized, as follows:

- Limited English Proficient (LEP): \$98.37
- Immigrant: \$92.95
- Supplemental Immigrant: \$27.73




## The Immigrant Program Supplemental Grant Awards

- Supplemental Immigrant Program award: Per Pupil amount is \$27.73
- This supplemental award was added to the regular Immigrant Program subgrant and will not be tracked separately on CARS
- This portion has a different expiration date than the rest of the allocation. This will be explained in the future
- Funding can be used for allowable activities identical to the regular immigrant program funding

### 2013–14 Subgrantee Awards


- 2013–14 Title III, Part A per pupil amounts:
  - Limited English Proficient (LEP): \$102.22
  - Immigrant: \$93.32
- LEP & Immigrant grant allocations are now final
  - Grant period ends September 30, 2015
  - LEAs must file a Cash Management Data Collection (CMDC) report to receive their apportionments
  - Expenditure reports must also be filed in the Consolidated Application Reporting System (CARS)

# Title III Improvement Status Requirements



- \*Plan to ensure that all AMAOs are met
- \*\*Adjust and Implement the Plan to specifically address factors preventing the LEA from meeting all AMAOs
- \*\*\*The LEA must address in the Plan modifications to the curriculum, program and method of instruction
- \*\*\*\*Plan adjusts Year 4 requirements by developing a budget justification that links TIII expenditures to the curriculum, program and instructional changes the LEA plans to make to ensure AMAOs are met.




### U.S. Department of Education Recent Guidance

- Purpose: to clarify how the U.S Department of Education (ED) expects State Educational Agencies to hold Local Educational Agencies accountable for meeting Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives (AMAOs)
- The guidance clarifies the accountability requirements for:
  - LEAs in Year 3
  - LEAs in Year 4 Plus
  - LEAs that receive a Title III, Part A Subgrant for Immigrant Children and Youth



# Title III Accountability Key Dates and Activities

- July 2015: Preliminary 2014-15 Accountability Reports (AMAOs 1 & 2)
- Fall 2015: The 2014-15 Public Release of Accountability Reports (AMAOs 1, 2, and 3 and Research File)
- Title I and Title III LEAs in improvement status are notified by mail
- 120 days after Release of Accountability Reports: Improvement Plan Addendum (IPA) due to CDE
  - Plans are reviewed by the CDE criteria
  - The Title III Plan Review Criteria posted



### Plan Review Follow Up

CDE sends a feedback letter to inform an LEA that the IPA has been reviewed.

The LEA needs to check the evaluation criteria to see what further action is necessary.

- Accepted Plans
  - No further information needed
- Needs further action
  - Contains missing sections
  - Clarification / more information needed
- Missing
  - A plan must be submitted in CAIS


