## INTRODUCTION

This is the Product Requirements Document for the Visual Dashboard and Heads-Up Display of Patient Conditions. The purpose of this document is to provide a checklist of product features and functionality. The list is intended to communicate expectations and ensure compliance in final deliverable prototypes. Further, the list will aid in error detection and prevention. This document will change over each quarterly deliverable, but stands as a statement of current understandings. As this is the first quarterly release, focus has been on representative features of the prominent modules: patient and provider. Subsequent iterations of this document will more fully enumerate features of modules glossed over here.

The Visual Dashboard and Heads-Up Display of Patient Conditions is a prototype Internet application. It will be implemented in the Adobe Flash environment based on requirements gathered from stakeholders and designs generated by Parsons Institute for Information Mapping (PIIM). Functionally, the application is partitioned into modules, or "Portals", based on user group, with an additional module for login. Within each module, related functionality is grouped into "widgets" such that a portal can be configurable and customizable.
