



## Extended Fraud Alert Request Form

Your credit file is owned by CSC Credit Services, the credit reporting agency that owns the credit files of consumers living in your area. Equifax is authorized to place fraud alerts on CSC credit files on behalf of CSC.

To place an extended fraud alert on your credit file please send to Equifax – via Fax or US Mail - a valid police report, law enforcement agency report, or US Postal service report that allege mail theft. In addition, please provide a photo-copy of one item from each of the categories below in order to verify your identification and address. The item you select from the identity category must contain your Social Security number and the item you select from the address category must contain your current mailing address.

- \*Drivers License
- \*Rental Lease Agreement/House Deed
- \*Pay Stub with Address
