#### SECTION 1 — BAKED PRODUCTS

- 1. All entries will be accepted Monday from 2 to 5 and 7 to 9 p.m. Hershey Cakes (only) may be entered during regular hours on Monday, and/or on Tuesday from 10 a.m. until 11:30 a.m..
  - 2. No commercial exhibits accepted. Items must be made by the exhibitor.
  - 3. Please use disposable plates or containers.
  - 4. Use zip-lock bags to package baked goods, to protect from dryness and insects.
  - 5. The fair will not be responsible for the return of any pans or plates.
- 6. All entries are to be brought to the exhibtion hall of the Grange Building, using the ramp entrance.

Entries will be accepted MONDAY from 2 to 4 and 7 to 9 p.m. or TUESDAY from 10 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. (this class only).

- Open to any individual who is a Pennsylvania resident.

  Entry must be a layered cake made from scratch and frosted (original recipes encouraged).

  A minimum of ½ (one-quarter) cup of HERSHEY'S COCOA must be used and listed in recipe.
- If the cake frosting is chocolate, HERSHEY'S COCOA must be used and listed in recipe
- Cake entry must submitted for judging on cardboard (no doily required).

  Recipe(s) listing the ingredients and the preparation instructions must be submitted with the entry (printed on one side of card)
- 7. Any cake requiring refrigeration after baking will not be accepted.

JUDGING will be based on the following criteria:

Overall appearance (25%), Consistency (15%), Moistness and Crumb (20%), Flavor (30%), Topping or Icing (10%).

### **SECTION 2 — CANNED PRODUCTS**

- 1. Some entries in canned goods may be opened during judging if the judge so desires.
- 2. Canned foods to be judged on quality, general appearance, and container.
- 3. Use standard mason-type, clear quart/pint glass jars for preserving and exhibiting fruits, vegetables, and meats. One-half pints must be used for jams, jellies and preserves.
  - 4. Use two-piece, self-sealing lids (flat discs and metal screw bands) for sealing all jars of food.
