Information:

- All registration forms must be turned in no later than **WEDNESDAY December 10.** Fill out the attached registration form and return the form in your child's folder in an envelope marked "PTA mailbox Talent Show". **Please keep this sheet for future reference.**
- All previews, rehearsals and performances take place in Edgemont's multipurpose room.

Show Guidelines

- 1. Group acts, solo acts, instrumental acts (group or solo) are welcome.
- 2. Group acts must come to all rehearsals at the same time.
- 3. Solo acts can be up to 1 ½ minutes: Group acts can be up to 2 minutes. Groups having more that 4 people, up to 2 ½ minutes is ok.
- 4. No Lip-syncing (i.e. mouthing the words to a song without actually singing).
- 5. Edgemont students' siblings can perform if performing with an Edgemont student. And Teachers can perform at the show.
- 6. Each child may appear in one act.
- 7. Attendance is mandatory for all acts. This includes preview and all rehearsals.
- 8. We will have a full ensemble opening act and finale act. Please select which one your child prefers to participate in, if any, and we will do our best to adhere to their request. No promises.
- 9. **PRACTICE MUST BE DONE AT HOME**. Rehearsals will be used only for staging and opening/finale practice.
- 10. There must be at least one parent/caregiver with each act during rehearsals. No drop-offs!
- 11. Visual works of art will be displayed in the show area; separate from the stage. They must be dropped off at the School by 3pm on January 22nd in order to be displayed.
