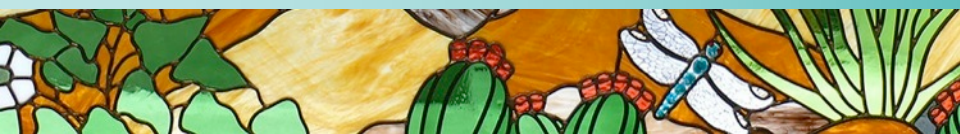
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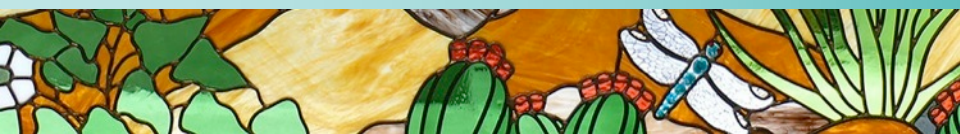


Quality Care is Not Enough

 - Native Americans have highest rates

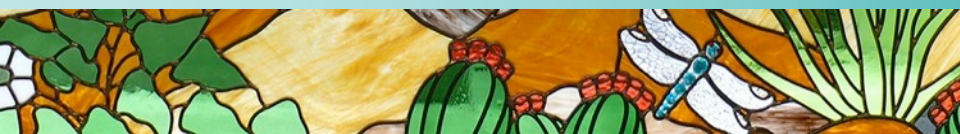

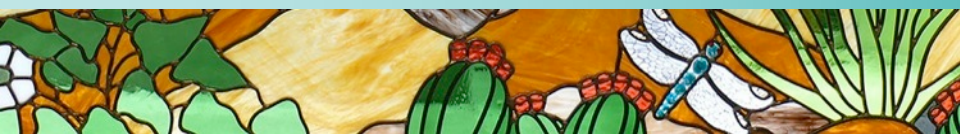


Map of HEROs and their regions



Components of HERO Hub







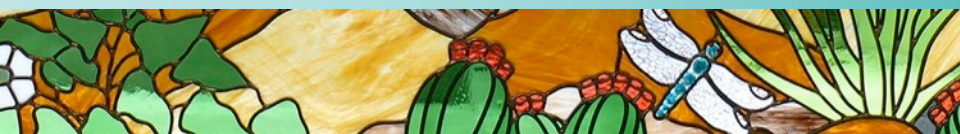
