# **Council-in-Committee Meeting Minutes**

### Monday, April 20, 2015

# 6. Public Meetings

(a) Black Creek Municipal Drain

Re: Engineer's Report

Mayor Redekop announced that this portion of the meeting would be devoted to the holding of a Public Meeting as provided for under the *Drainage Act, R.S.O. 1990* Chapter C.17, to consider the Engineer's Report for the Black Creek Municipal Drain. He called on Mr. Dave Maiden, Drainage Superintendent to provide background information.

Mr. Maiden stated the purpose of the report is to establish a new schedule of assessment for future maintenance that accurately defines the affected properties and provides an equitable means to assign costs. The report is not to authorize work. He introduced Mr. Neal Morris of K. Smart Associates who prepared the Engineer's Report.

Mr. Morris described the process of arriving at the new assessment schedule. He stated some of the existing assessment schedules were up to 60 years old and there have been improvements to calculating assessment schedules since then. He stated the cost of the Engineer's Report is \$67,000 to be assessed against approximately 903 properties in the drainage area. He re-iterated the purpose of the meeting is for Council to deal with technical matters or refer the report back to the Engineer for gross errors and that the resulting costs are a matter for the Court of Revision.

Mayor Redekop asked if anyone in attendance had questions about the report.

Gord Albert, 4811 Sherk Road, Stevensville, asked about potential cost.

Julia Murray, 3358 Troup Road, Port Colborne asked about the agricultural rebate, the projected costs and requested additional information about when any work is going to be done.

Mr. Morris stated that any agricultural rebates would be applied by the municipality. He stated the cost of the Engineers Report is being assessed on the basis of \$50 for properties 1.5 hectares or less and \$200 for everyone else. He stated calculations in the report are purely theoretical and do not represent actual assessments.

In response to a question, Mr. Morris replied that Fort Erie fulfilled the notification requirements by providing access to the Engineer's Report in electronic format.

Jim Puhl, 3811 Rebstock Road, Crystal Beach asked whether property owners in new subdivisions would be assessed. Mr. Morris replied in the affirmative.

Dave Kobelka, 4977 Church Road, Stevensville asked for a description of maintenance. Mr. Morris replied that it is mostly brushing, ditch clean-out and bank stabilization.

Mr. O. Daniel, 5762 Baker Road, Niagara Falls asked about ways to lower his assessed costs.

Patricia Henderson, 4635 Netherby Road, Stevensville asked whether assessed costs can be paid over time. Mr. Maiden replied in the affirmative.

Roger Robert spoke on behalf of the Niagara Antique Power Association, 1967 Wilhelm Road, Port Colborne. He stated the association is a non-profit organization and expressed concerns about the affordability of any maintenance works.

Willard Storm, Road 1, Sherkston asked whether the Peter Storm Drain was included in the watershed. Mr. Morris replied in the negative.

Arden Hill, 4335 Church Road, Fort Erie asked whether his property was included in the watershed. Mr. Maiden stated he would conduct a site visit.

Ron Beaulieu, 2973 Wilhelm Road, Port Colborne asked whether the proposed works were going to be in addition to work recently done. Mr. Maiden stated he would conduct a site visit.

Homer Van der meer, 2909 Point Abino Road, Fort Erie enquired whether a creek on his property was included in the watershed. Mr. Morris answered in the negative.

Ms. Murray asked whether protected wetlands on her property would reduce her assessment. Mr. Morris replied in the affirmative

In response to a question, Mr. Morris stated the watershed starts at Sherk Road and ends at Winger Road. There is a section of Black Creek that is a natural watercourse and not a municipal drain.

The Mayor adjourned the Public Meeting.
