- 3. Your report should include the following:
 - a. **Title:** Title the report using the name of the career.
 - b. <u>Description:</u> Describe the career. Discuss what kind of work is done, what you have to do, what responsibilities you have, people you supervise, people who work for you, etc. What exactly would you do on this job? What companies or organizations hire people in this career field? Discuss the responsibilities of the job (money, supervising employees, saving lives, controlling inventory, etc.). What are the working conditions (outside, inside, office, dangerous, etc.)
 - c. **Education/Training:** Is there a special certification or license required? Where can you get the training or education required for this work and what will it cost to get this training? Do you have to have a college degree? What colleges offer a degree in this field? What type of degree do you have to have (Bachelors, Masters, Doctorate, etc.)?
 - d. <u>Job Outlook:</u> What is the future outlook for this career? Will there be job opportunities or not? Is the career in demand? Is the field experiencing layoffs? What locations have the best job outlook? Will you have to move to a different city or state to work in this career field?
 - e. **Technology:** How is technology used in this career field?
 - f. <u>Future:</u> What are your future plans and how do they fit into this career? Will you be able to balance family life with your job? What kind of advancement (promotion) opportunities are there? Do you plan to move? Will the job be available there?
 - g. Salary: What is your expected salary when you first enter the job field?
 - h. <u>High School Preparation</u>: What high school classes should you take to prepare for your career path (grades 9-12).
