# Memphis Redbirds (35-38) vs. Round Rock Express (41-32)

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Redbirds continue a four-game series with the Round Rock Express (Triple-A Rangers) tonight at the Dell Diamond. It is the sixth of 16 scheduled meeting between the teams in 2013. Round Rock leads the season series, 3-2. Memphis leads the all-time series, 70-60, since 2005, when the club transitioned to Triple-A status. Tonight's game will be broadcast live on Sports 56. 87.7 FM, and internet webcast at www.memphisredbirds. com. Steve Selby is on the call.

SALAS SCHEDULED TO REHAB WITH REDBIRDS: Righthanded reliever Fernando Salas is scheduled to join the Redbirds this series in Round Rock to begin a rehab assignment. The 28-year-old has been sidelined with right shoulder inflammation since May 21. Salas has gone 0-2 with a 3.86 ERA (7er/16.1ip) and 12 strikeouts in 15 games with St. Louis to begin the season.

ANGRY BIRDS: Memphis has lost six games in a row, which is the club's longest losing skid since the Redbirds lost nine straight from May 6-14, 2012.

BROCKIN' IN MEMPHIS: First baseman Brock Peterson has hit safely in 25 of his last 34 games at a .355 clip (44-for-125). The slugger ranks 2nd in the PCL in extra-base hits (37), tied for 2nd in homers (15) and doubles (22), 3rd in total bases (142), and 5th in slugging (.577). Peterson has reached base safely in his last 22 consecutive road games since May 2, which is the longest streak in the PCL this season.

WHOLE LOTTA GLOVE: The Redbirds share the PCL lead with Colorado Springs and Tucson with a .981 fielding percentage. Memphis has committed 52 errors this season (2nd in the PCL behind Tucson's 50), including 20 defensive gaffs in the last 12 games. The Redbirds are 26-12 when not committing an error.

**SAFE:** Memphis has stolen 52 bases in 63 opportunities (82.5%) for the highest stolen base percentage in the league. Omaha is 2nd with 59 swipes in 72 chances (81.9%).

RAKING ROMAK: Utilityman Jamie Romak ranks 4th in the PCL with 34 extra-base hits. tied for 4th with 13 home runs and, tied for 5th with 20 doubles, and 8th in slugging percentage (.538). Romak has produced an extra-base hit in his last four straight games.

DH DIGITS: The Redbirds are 19-15 when facing an AL affiliate. (13-8 on the road). Redbirds designated hitters are batting .280 (35-for-125) with five homers, 11 doubles and 21 RBIs.

AND THE OSCAR GOES TO: Outfielder Oscar Taveras is hitting .318 (21-for-66) over his last 15 starts, and has batted safely in 19 of his last 26 starts overall at a .311 clip (33-for-106). However, Taveras is just 1-for-his-last-18.

THE WONG SHOW: Second base prospect Kolten Wong is hitting safely in 37 of his last 43 games at a .331 clip (58for-175). The 22-year-old is tied for 5th in the PCL in triples (5) and hits (83), and tied for 10th in total bases (122).

GO GARCIA GO: Infielder Greg Garcia is hitting .293 (13for-45) with five doubles and two triples over his last 15 games since June 1. The 23-year-old is batting .308 (8-for-26) over a season-best seven-game hitting streak.

CURTIS IN THE CLUTCH: Jermaine Curtis has hit safely in 13 of his last 17 games at a .315 clip (17-for-54) with two homers and two doubles. He leads the team with a .353 average (18-for-51) and 31 RBIs with runners in scoring position.

RISP-Y BUSINESS: The Redbirds are hitting just .208 (10for-44) with 38 runners left on base over their current sixgame losing streak.

HANGIN' HUFF: Outfielder Chad Huffman has hit safely in 13 of his last 15 starts at a .405 clip (17-for-42).

THIS DAY IN REDBIRDS HISTORY: In an attempt to bounce back from injury in 2008, left-hander Mark Mulder made his third and final rehab start for Memphis and lasted only 3.2 innings, allowing six runs on 10 hits in an 11-6 loss to Albuquerque. Mulder went 0-3, pitching 13.1 innings and yielding 22 earned runs on 28 hits.

BIRD BYTES: Happy 21st birthday to outfielder Oscar Taveras ... Until today. Memphis had been in sole possession of first place for the last 28 games since May 21 ... The Redbirds have outscored the opposition by a 101-47 margin over the first two innings this season ... Memphis pitching has allowed 49 homers this season, the fewest amount in the PCL ... Memphis starters have compiled 10 losses in June, equaling their first two months combined.
