

Behavioral Health Services Home Start (HS) Children's Care Connection (C3)	Home Start provides Home based Parent Child Interactive Therapy (PCIT), in which parents are taught and 'coached' how to develop consistently positive communication with their child and to implement effective discipline and child management skills is provided. Home Visitation for At-Risk Families Welcome Home Baby (WHB)	Multi-disciplinary home visiting program for at risk families is provided up to 15 months of child's life; including Social Work, Health Educator, and Registered Dietician visits. Health and Behavioral Consultant Services for Early Care and Education Providers YMCA Childcare Resource Services (YMCA-CRS)	Behavioral consultation and technical assistance are available to licensed and license-exempt early care and education providers and parents of children in early learning programs.	Referrals made to YMCA-CRS at (800) 908-8883 or through the Regional Coordinator at (877) 504-2229. Child must be enrolled in early child care within San Diego County, and services must be parent initiated.
