## **Financial Aid Application Instructions**

Applications for room and board Financial Aid are available to graduate or upper division UC Berkeley registered international students, US citizens and permanent residents who have demonstrated financial need and meet all other qualifications. (Read all instructions)

The purpose of the financial aid program is to offer UC Berkeley students who demonstrate financial need an opportunity to experience firsthand, cultures from all over the world while enabling international students to learn about the ethnic and economic diversity in the United States. To be considered for financial assistance, an applicant <u>must have full-time upper division or graduate standing, have a room reserved at I-House for 2015-16 (or Fall 2015) and be in a **degree-granting** program at UC Berkeley.</u>
