Dear Parents or Guardian,

From Monday, April 9th until Friday, April 13th, our physical education classes will be participating in an in-house roller skating unit. Skates will be rented to us through a company called Skatetime, and they will deliver the skates to Park View for the week. Due to insurance purposes, we will be exclusively using Skatetime skates. It will be mandatory for students to wear helmets but wrist, elbow and knee guards are available but optional.

This unit is being implemented because of its emphasis on "Lifetime Activity" and because it is going to be a lot of fun! Skating provides a variety of health benefits, which include balance, coordination, motor skills, and a top notch cardiovascular workout. This program will be done for all grades at Park View and basic skating skills and safety will be addressed during the unit.

The fee for this unit is \$7 dollars per student for the entire week. Students not choosing to skate will do an alternative activity but skating will be a great time! Checks should be payable to Park View School or cash will also be accepted. **Last day to sign up is Friday, March 16th!**

Skating of course comes with risks associated with falling down or falling into something. We will be giving safety tips but there is certainly a risk of injury during the unit. We believe the benefits far outweigh the risks and hope you decide to skate with us. In consideration of the permission granted I hereby grant permission for the person named herein to participate in the program described and associated activities provided by Skatetime School Programs and Park View School. I further release Skatetime School Programs and Park View School and its teachers from all actions, damages, claims, or demands and liability, which might be incurred during the conduct of this activity.
