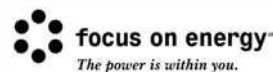


Building Operator Certification

Why Attend This Workshop:

The Building Operator Certification (BOC) program is a competency-based training and certification for building operators, designed to improve the energy efficiency of commercial buildings. Operators earn certification by attending training sessions and completing project assignments in their facilities. The certification provides a credential for their professional development while also offering employers a way to identify skilled operators.

- Building Managers
- Maintenance Staff
- Building Operators
- Utility Representatives

The eight (56 hours) training sessions will improve your current skills in troubleshooting and maintaining optimal performance of building systems. You will better understand your facility's operational characteristics, energy consumption and maintenance status.

Fee: \$1,025 / attendee – eight training sessions over four months includes handbooks, project assignments, certification materials, continental breakfast and lunch.

Scholarships: Up to \$700 is available. Madison Gas and Electric customers receive a \$200 BOC tuition credit. Focus on Energy partners will receive \$150 tuition credit; an additional \$350 is available if a project is implemented after course completion.
