With a strong background as a bicultural/bilingual health educator, outreach liaison, and Hmong community advocate, Deu is highly respected in both Hmong and western health care audiences.

As a cultural health care bridge between systems, Deu currently serves as Clinical Liaison for Older Adults at UCare Minnesota. She specializes in complex clinical and family situations involving Hmong elders, adult children and their families, and health care providers.

Linda Debner, RN, MA is the Director of Community Education and Quality Management for Hospice of the Twin Cities, a not-for-profit, Medicare certified hospice program serving Minneapolis, St. Paul, and surrounding communities. Linda is responsible for on-going education for local medical and lay communities in end-of-life care issues, palliative care, and hospice care. She educates communities on hospice care principles and practices, and helps to remove barriers to early referral and admission of patients in hospice care.

In serving more than 12 years with Hospice of the Twin Cities, Linda continues to foster healthy working relationships between the hospice team, its referring sources, and the greater Twin Cities community.
