Directions: You found the following resources for a report you are writing about being a Middle School student. Use index cards to create correctly formatted citations for the report. When finished, place the cards in the correct order for a works cited page.

BOOK WITH ONE AUTHOR

Format: Last Name, First Name. Title of Book. City of publication: Name of publisher, year of publication.

Source Info: The book's name is *The Joy of Research Papers* by Lori Christianson. It was published in New York in 2008 by Simon and Schuster.

A BOOK WITH AN EDITOR

- Format: Last name, First Name, ed. Title of Book. City of publication: Name of publisher, year of publication.
- **Source Info**: The book's name is *There's No Such Thing as Too Much Homework*. It was edited by Bradley J. Ryder, Jr. It was published in Philadelphia in 2008 by Doubleday.

A BOOK WITH TWO AUTHORS

Format: Last Name, First Name and First Name Last Name. Title of Book. City of publication: Name of publisher, year of publication.

Note: the authors' names should be listed alphabetically according to last name.

Source Info: The title of the book is, *The Secret Lives of Middle School Students*. It was written by Beverly Weidendorf and Jay N. Burnett. It was published in 2008 in Boston by Houghton Mifflin Co.

A MAGAZINE ARTICLE

- Format: Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." Name of Magazine. Date: Page Number(s).
- **Source Info**: You used an article titled "Getting Along With the Teacher" by Duane Talhouk on pages 70-71 of the magazine *Teacher Weekly*. The date of the magazine is September 27, 2012.

A WEBSITE FROM AN ORGANIZATION

Format: Name of institution. "Title of site's specific page."
Name of full site. Date of site's last revision.
Date you accessed the site. <URL>.
Note: Your teacher wants you to include the URL.

Source Info: You found a web site called "How to Write Great Paragraphs" that is published by the United Language Arts Teachers. The site is called *Success in Middle School Language Arts*. It was last updated July 17, 2012. You found it on today's date at http://www.englishteacher.com.

AN INDIVIDUAL PAGE ON A WEBSITE WITH NO AUTHOR

Format: "Name of Page." Name of site. Date of site's last revision. Name of institution or organization affiliated with the site. Date you accessed the site. <URL>.

Note: Your teacher wants you to include the URL.

Source Info: You found a web page titled "Success in Middle School" on the web site called *Advice for Today's Teenagers*. No author was given, but the site was last updated on May 23, 2012. You accessed it on today's date at http://www.todaysteens.com
