Merit Award Information

-  Grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale demonstrated by submitting an official transcript
-  Verification of attendance requirement of 6 or less unexcused absences per semester of the junior or senior year.
-  Verification of no major discipline infractions during the junior or senior year
-  Provide two letters of recommendation — one letter from a person in the community of no relation to you and another from a school official such as a teacher, counselor, principal, coach, etc.
-  Senior Students selected for the award must submit the verification of enrollment to a post-secondary education program before the check will be issued
-  Submit a typed essay between 500 - 650 words on the topic included in the application.
-  Application and essay will be typed and submitted electronically to tritchey@tenaris.com by the due date.
-  Use a paper clip to attach two letters of recommendation and transcript. These may be submitted to the designated high school counselor.
-  All documents are due by February 29th at the end of the school day.

-  Successful applicants will be announced at an awards ceremony on Monday, May 9th at 6 pm in the high school auditorium. **Students selected for the awards are required to attend the ceremony**
