Seminar Description

Special Inspection of Structural Masonry Construction Thursday, April 26, 2012– 8 am to 5 pm

Recently updated to the 2009 IBC, this seminar is perfect for those needing to inspect masonry but who are unfamiliar with its construction, and for everyone considering taking the ICC/TMS Structural Masonry Special Inspectors Certification Examination. Those needing a refresher on inspection and masonry construction will also find the seminar valuable.

Topics covered will include:

- Basic masonry terms
- Masonry material requirements including brick, block, mortar, reinforcement, connectors, and grout
- Proper mortar mixing
- Explanation of basic masonry construction techniques: unit placement, installation of pipes and conduits, and placement of reinforcement
- Proper grout mixing and placement
- Explanation of field test procedures: inspection of masonry units; fresh mortar and grout; and the preparation, handling, and storage of prisms
- Proper preparation, construction, and protection procedures when dealing with both hot and cold weather construction conditions
- Explanation of inspection duties and reporting responsibilities


Registration fees include the seminar handout, continental breakfast, lunch, and afternoon break.

In addition, attendees may also wish to bring a copy of the Reinforced Concrete Masonry Special Inspectors Handbook, 7th Edition which is an excellent field reference. All of these materials will be needed by those planning to take the ICC Special masonry Special Inspector’s Certification Exam.
