INTENT: To encourage and assist any full or part-time student in the academic, vocational, trade or graduate school of their choice.

PROCEDURE: <u>Please read all the instructions below for what's required in submitting a complete</u> <u>application.</u>

- 1. The *Deadline* for submitting applications for scholarship is **May 1**, (should it fall on a Sunday, May 2 is acceptable). Applications may be hand-delivered, or if mailed, it must be postmarked **May 1**.
- 2. The submitted application must be legible and completed in black ink (pencil is unacceptable), if handwritten. A typewritten, double-spaced application is preferred.
- 3. We ask that all applications be emailed to edyehill@yahoo.com so that we can email to the rest of the scholarship committee.
- 4. All received applications will be acknowledged by email or mail.
- 5. You will receive notification to the exact date and time of the interviews after May 30th. Out-of-State applicants may be interviewed via teleconference. If you have not received acknowledgment within 5 days of mailing application please contact Edye Hill at edyehill@yahoo.com.
- 6. All scholarship recipients shall notify the Scholarship Committee Chairperson in writing of any changes in student status (e.g. full-time status to part-time status, or withdrawal).

Additional document requirements:

- **1.** An essay with a maximum of 300 words which should include the following information:
 - a. A short biography
 - b. What you have accomplished this past year
 - c. Extracurricular activities / work experience in the past year
 - d. Community service / volunteer work in the past year
 - e. Participation in a Hawaiian organization, if any, in the past year
 - f. Possible future contributions towards Hawaiian community culture
- 1. Your most recent official transcript from an accredited school.
- 2. Two (2) letters of recommendation from individuals other than your parent or guardian.
- 3. Signed Agreement Form. The Agreement Form shall become null and void in the event you are not selected as a scholarship recipient.
