We will be supporting PinkRibbonGirls.org. The Pink

Ribbon Girls is a local organization with many people from the Tipp City area involved. The Pink Ribbon Girls' mission is to provide personalized support to young women throughout all phases of the breast cancer journey. They accomplish this through education, outreach, awareness, and one-on-one support to women and their families.

Support

The Pink Ribbon Girls Organization offers support and services to their members through their <u>Simply Fight</u> and <u>No Age No Stage</u> programs which offer free services for those in treatment to help with life needs such as housekeeping, babysitting, meals and transportation. Survivors can also connect via our secure national database.

Awareness

They create awareness in the community that young women do indeed get diagnosed with breast cancer. We work to positively impact the community through Pink Game Days and other breast cancer awareness events. Their goal is to communicate that 1 in 8 women gets diagnosed with breast cancer in their lifetime and therefore impacts their family and friends. They strive to rally around these survivors and create awareness that No One Travels This Road Alone!

Education

Their <u>Love Your Girls</u> program provides education and support through our website, social and print media, as well as public speaking forums. They collaborate with other breast cancer organizations and research groups such as The University of Cincinnati Medical Center Department of Environmental Health's <u>Windows of Susceptibility</u> Grant in order to educate the public about breast cancer basics, healthy living and ways to understand breast cancer research findings.
