BSYAA CHEERLEADING RULES AND REGULATIONS

GOAL: You are representatives of Bermudian Springs Youth Athletic Association and we expect you to put your best foot forward at all times in the classroom, games, practices and that means we build our school's and/or an individual's spirit up without ever putting another school or person down.

PRACTICES: Because this is a team sport, all participants should be there for every practice in order to perform well together. We appreciate a commitment from both the child and the parent to make this work.

Each cheerleader should wear comfortable clothing that corresponds with the weather conditions. Acceptable attire: Shorts, t-shirts, sweats, socks and sneakers. Clothing must be in Bermudian colors. Don't forget your pom-poms! You do not need to bring your uniform to practice. If you are not dressed in the attire listed, you will need to watch practice that day. This is a safety precaution to prevent injuries. It is the cheerleader's responsibility to take their water bottle with them after each practice, or throw it in the trash.

No gum chewing at practices or games

All participants should be picked up immediately after a practice or game. Parents should make their presence known to a coach before taking their child. When carpooling, please notify the coaches with a written note at the beginning of practice.

Games: For all games, all cheerleaders must arrive at the field 40 minutes prior to the start of the game. At this time attendance will be taken, cheers and dance reviewed, and the hello cheer performed for the opposing team. All Items to the complete cheer uniform must be brought to every game.

UNIFORMS: The organization will provide cheer skirts, cheer tops, and sweatshirt.

Each cheerleader is responsible to keep their uniform clean, including sneakers! If you should stain or ruin any part of the uniform provided by BSYAA, you will have to replace it.

All participants are responsible for cleaning up trash. This includes the practice fields, that are at away games and stands at our home games.
