² Prior to the commencement of the 2012 season you will be required to furnish: (1) an original birth certificate (or passport) for all new players; (2) an original report card for June/4th Quarter 2012; and (3) copy (front and back) of players' health insurance card. The birth certificate and report card will be returned prior to the commencement of the season in September.

□ <i>Vacations:</i> It is understood that family vacations and functions may conflict with the practice schedule. I have been advised that attendance at practice is of paramount importance and that a failure to attend to attend practice is often a significant factor in a coach's decision to cut any cheerleader.

Minimum Volunteer Obligations: While the Gladiators strive to balance minimal fundraising obligations with registration fees, I understand that each season the Gladiators pay a significant sum towards field and facilities maintenance, lights, equipment purchase and refurbishing, etc. Apart from registration fees, I am aware that the Gladiators only revenue source is a Pancake Breakfast. I understand that each enrolled player or cheerleader will be expected to sell or purchase a minimum of five (5) Pancake Breakfast tickets. I also understand that Gladiator parents or guardians are expected to work a minimum of one three-hour shift per year at one home game per enrolled player or cheerleader. (For example, a parent who has enrolled two participants in the program will be expected to work a minimum of 2 hours per year at 2 or more home games.) I have been advised that the date and type of service (snack bar, set-up, clean-up, security, etc.) will be assigned by my Head A.D. I further understand that if I have a conflict with my assigned game duty, date or time, it is my obligation to notify my Head A.D. at least one week prior to the assigned game and to arrange make-up work. I understand that volunteer obligations normally will be scheduled approximately two hours before my child's game or event and that, if I want to volunteer during my child's event it is incumbent on me to so advise my team's AD. I understand that failure to comply with volunteer duties may result in fines, reduced playing time or both.

Fees and Refunds: The structure of fees and costs relating to cheerleaders is different from that of football. I understand that the entire amount of the overall cheer fee (\$420) is due and owing at the time this application is submitted. I have been advised that the "Registration Fee" for Cheerleaders is \$120 and is NOT INCLUSIVE of the other remaining costs and expenses related to uniform and equipment expenses. Once my child is fitted and her uniform and warm-up suit are ordered there will be no refunds for any reason whatsoever relating to the "Uniform Fee". If,

Personality Incompatibility: I understand that the Gladiator Board, staff and coaches are all unpaid volunteers. I also understand that sometimes disagreements arise between parents and youth sports coaches over a variety of issues. I understand that the Gladiators *will not issue any refund whatsoever* if I withdraw my child from the program due to personality or other disputes as between or among my child's coach, myself and/or the Gladiator Executive Board.

After the beginning of the season, if my child voluntarily withdraws from the program for *any* reason, including, but not limited to, a failure to maintain the required GPA, or if my child is removed for disciplinary reasons, I understand that *I am not entitled to any refund*. Academics: The Gladiators and Jr. All American Football place a premium on academics. Participation in youth sports is a privilege, not a right. If, at any time during the season, my child's grades fall below 2.0 then my child will not be permitted to continue with the program and *I will not be entitled to any refund whatsoever*.

Parental Misconduct: If a parent is asked to leave the program at any time for misconduct, *no refund will be issued whatsoever.*

Discipline: One of the purposes of youth sports is to instill a sense of order and discipline. I understand that if my child is unruly or excessively disruptive to the point that it interferes with the orderly conduct of the team or cheer squad, his or her coach will first discuss this with me. If my child's conduct does not thereafter improve, he may be asked to leave the team. I understand that if this occurs, *I will not be entitled to any refund whatsoever.*

Post-Certification: After Certification Day, if my child voluntarily withdraws from the program for *any* reason, including, but not limited to, a failure to maintain the required GPA, injury after Certification Day or my refusal to consent to move my child to another team within the Gladiators because of weight problems, or dispute with the Gladiator organization or any member thereof, then *I am not entitled to any refund whatsoever*.

☐ Geographical Location: I have been advised that Conference rules require that all participants in the Gladiator program be located within its recruiting area (La Cañada) or an "open" area (La Crescenta, Tujunga, parts of Altadena and Pasadena). I understand that if I reside in an area that falls outside these areas, I will need special permission from Conference to cheer for the Gladiators. If I cannot obtain this, I understand that my child will not be able to cheer for the Gladiators.

Cheerleader Conduct: I have been advised that the Gladiators place great emphasis on conduct and behavior. All cheerleaders are expected to respect their fellow teammates, parents and coaches, and at all times display a positive and respectful attitude toward cheerleaders and parents from other cities within Conference. I have also been advised that attendance at all practice sessions is important. Cheerleading routines have become intricate and require a great deal of coordination, and this is achieved only when all members of a cheer squad practice regularly together. If, at any time, my child fails to display a proper attitude toward her fellow cheerleaders, displays disrespect to parents, officials or coaches, or regularly misses cheer practice sessions, this will be brought to my attention by a coach or other representative of the Gladiator organization. If, after this consultation, my child's conduct/attendance does not improve, she will be removed from the squad. The decision to remove a cheerleader based on conduct or attitude is within the sole discretion of the Gladiator organization. If my child is removed due to disciplinary/attendance reasons, I understand that I am not entitled to a refund.

GPA throughout the school year. Grades are checked at the beginning of each season and again during October. Conference and/or the Gladiators may also randomly check grades during the season. I agree to assist Conference and the Gladiators and I will not withhold academic information from them. I also agree not to alter or in any way attempt to deceive Conference or the Gladiators as to my child's academic records or information. I will timely assist them in obtaining any necessary information from my child's school in order to comply with this requirement. I have been advised that academic falsifications or alterations will result in my child's immediate dismissal from the program and could also result in his or her being banned from any team in Conference the following season. I have also been advised that academic falsifications or alterations could result in severe sanctions against the team on which my child participates. If, at any time, my child's grades fall below the required GPA, or I refuse to allow Conference or the Gladiators reasonable access to academic information, I understand that my child will be ineligible to continue to participate. The Gladiator program does not allow any of its participants to apply for academic probation. If my child's GPA falls below 2.0 he or she will be immediately dismissed from the program.

□ Gladiator Emphasis on Scholastics and Sportsmanship: I understand that during playoffs, which typically occur during the first three weeks in November, Conference honors scholarship and sportsmanship award winners from each team. These ceremonies require the recipients to attend in person to receive their respective award(s). I understand that attendance is mandatory at these functions regardless of whether any of our teams are participating in playoffs. I understand that the Gladiator Organization strongly emphasizes both sportsmanship and academics, and encourages parents and players to do likewise. I acknowledge that good character and scholastic achievement are both far more important than any transitory success in youth sports. I understand this commitment and will make every effort to attend these functions with my child if he or she is a recipient of a scholastic or sportsmanship award.
