Who is eligible?	<p>All international fee-paying students.</p> <p>Applicants who have studied Maths and Physics to the Equivalent of A Level Grade 'D'. Students must have a minimum English language proficiency equivalent to IELTS 5.5 with no less than IELTS 5.5 or equivalent in reading and writing elements.</p> <p>Students must be a minimum of 18 years old at the start of the International Diploma programme.</p> <p>EU international students are also eligible.</p>
General information	<p>Successful applicants will receive a scholarship worth £5745.00 which will be deducted from their International Diploma tuition fees.</p> <p>Upon successful completion (and subject to achieving specified grades for entry), students entering degree programmes at Queen's University Belfast will receive a further £5745.00 (which will be deducted from the university's Year 2 tuition fees).</p>

Application procedures	<p>Complete an INTO Queen's University Belfast Academic course application form. The Scholarships are only available to students who have submitted a course application and have received an offer. The completed course application form should be returned to INTO Admissions along with copies of your academic transcripts and evidence of current English language level.</p> <p>Complete a Queen's University Belfast International Diploma in Engineering Scholarship application form including a personal statement explaining why you want to study at Queen's University Belfast and how the degree programme will help you in the future. The personal statement must be hand-written in English and be no less 200 words and no more than 500 words. An application and personal statement form is included at the bottom of this announcement. Applicants may submit information and evidence of additional achievements in support of their application.</p> <p>All scholarship applications must be complete with transcripts and should be submitted to c.guiney@qub.ac.uk.</p>
Scholarship Deadlines	<p>For the January 2012 intake the deadline is Friday 2 December 2011.</p> <p>All scholarships applications received by this date will be considered.</p> <p>Successful candidates will be notified no later than two weeks after the deadline has passed.</p>

*Payment of the first instalment of the International Diploma in Engineering Scholarship, in the form of a fee discount, will be made only to successful scholarship applicants who have paid their full tuition fees at least 4 week before the start date of the International Diploma in Engineering Programme (Wednesday 8 December 2011). The remaining instalment will be discounted from the university's Year 2 tuition fees upon successful completion of the first semester of study in the second year of an undergraduate degree programme at Queen's University Belfast. Please note, this scholarship deduction will not exceed the INTO Queen's/Queen's University tuition fees and cannot be used in conjunction with any other discounts or scholarships.
