**Admission Prerequisites/ Requirements:** Effective Fall 2013 admissions, if the prerequisite GPA is between a 2.5 and 3.0, it is highly recommended that an academic plan be developed with the Nursing and Allied Health Counselor in order to provide a stronger foundation before entering the rigor of the Nursing program and complete the following: HLTH 140 and ENG 106 (or ENG 215).

**Complete program prerequisites with:** 1) A grade of "C" or higher (C- is not accepted). No more than two courses may be repeated once. 2) Minimum GPA 2.5 (e.g., 11 credits with a grade of "B" and 11 credits with a grade of "C"). 3) Reading COMPASS test score of 79 or greater or completed ENG 21 with a grade of "C" or higher. 4) Science courses must be completed within seven (7) years and math courses within three (3) from being qualified for the Nursing program.

**NOTE:** All second-level students will be required to complete a computerized pre-NCLEX readiness test (such as HESI) and achieve a satisfactory score (800). Student(s) failing to achieve a satisfactory score (800) will be required to complete a designated NCLEX-RN review course at his/her own expense before the AS Degree in Nursing can be confirmed.
