ATR VERDICT: Bonny Kate has taken to fences like a duck to water but, although hugely respected, there has to be doubts over her stamina (yet to race beyond 2m5f), so last year's winner EMBRACING CHANGE gets the vote. Robert Tyner's gelding did remarkably well in these long-distance staying handicaps last season and is entitled to improve for his comeback run over hurdles at Punchestown last month. He carries the same weight as when successful 12 months ago and another bold bid is forecast. Baie Des Iles needed every yard of the 3m1f trip to win here last time and she ought to appreciate this longer trip.
