RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PROGRAM

- Non- participating children under the age of 14 will need to be supervised by an adult during games and practices.
- Fighting, abuse of official(s), abuse of program coordinator, and abuse of property owned by City of Gallipolis, Gallipolis City Schools, First Church of God and Gallipolis Developmental Center, and other unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. These actions may lead to banishment of the team, player(s), coaches, or fans from the game or the entire program with no refund.
- Any coach or player who receives two direct technical fouls in one game will be banished from that game and the next game. If it occurs during the last game of the season, then the suspension will begin the first game of next year.
- A total of four direct technical fouls in a season will result in the banishment for the rest of the year.
- A spectator, who is thrown out of a game, will be banished from that game and the next game.
- Ejection by a fan of two games will result in banishment for the rest of the season.
- Profanity will not be tolerated. Technical fouls will occur in each case.
- If the game is out of hand, the official(s) or program coordinator has the right to stop the game and end play. Forfeit will occur for one or both teams.
- No running in hallways or seating areas at the facilities. You are a guest at these facilities and everyone should only be in the gymnasium or other appropriate places (i.e. restrooms, locker rooms)
