

Case Calm!

Case Calm is something wonderfully simple that we are implementing to help our students get in a mindset for learning.

Case Calm is techniques that help us get our mind and body ready to learn. We learn what it looks like, sounds like, and feels like to be focused and regulate our emotions and attention so our energy can go toward learning.



One of the easiest Case Calm techniques is a deep breath. When the children take a deep breath, it reminds them to get in the present moment and focus their attention where it needs to be. You can use Case Calm at home by encouraging your child to take a deep breath before starting homework or when your child seems scattered, anxious, angry, or unfocused. It really works! Please try this technique with your student and yourself. You might be surprised how calm and relaxed you truly feel.

TIPS FOR PREVENTING & DIFFUSING STUDENT CONFLICTS:

MANY PARENTS ARE CONCERNED ABOUT TEACHING THEIR CHILDREN HOW TO PROTECT THEMSELVES. HOWEVER, YOU NEED TO REMEMBER THAT WHEN YOUR CHILD IS FACED WITH A SITUATION WHERE THEIR SAFETY
IS IN CONCERN THEIR SURVIVAL INSTINCTS WILL AUTOMATICALLY KICK IN AND THEY WILL REACT APPROPRIATELY. EVEN IN DEFENSE CLASSES, SUCH AS KARATE, THEY TEACH THEIR STUDENTS TO AVOID GETTING
PHYSICAL UNLESS THERE IS NO OTHER WAY. IF ONE TEACHES THEIR CHILD TO HIT SOMEONE ELSE WHEN THEY
ARE IN ANY TYPE OF ARGUMENT OR DISAGREEMENT WITH ANOTHER THAT WILL BE THEIR FIRST RESPONSE
AND THEY WILL NOT LEARN HOW TO WORK THROUGH CONFLICTS WITH OTHERS. HERE ARE SOME TIPS THAT
WILL HELP YOU TEACH YOUR CHILD HOW TO DIFFUSE A CONFLICT:

- EMPHASIZE EARLY ON THAT NO BULLYING OR ANY OTHER FORM OF PHYSICAL OR VERBAL VIOLENCE WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- ENCOURAGE THEM TO TALK TO A STAFF MEMBER OR ADULT ABOUT ANY FORM OF BULLYING, PHYSICAL OR VERBAL VIOLENCE THAT OCCURS TO THEM. DO NOT LET THEM JUST IGNORE THE SITUATION. OFTEN, STUDENTS COME TO PHYSICAL ALTERCATIONS OVER THEIR FEELINGS BUT HAVE NEVER SPOKEN TO ANYONE ABOUT WHAT WAS HAPPENING. WE CANNOT HELP IF WE DO NOT KNOW ABOUT A SITUATION.
- TEACH THEM THE IMPORTANCE OF WALKING AWAY UNLESS THEY ARE IN A LIFE THREATENING SITUATION AND ARE UNABLE TO GET AWAY. STRESS THAT VIOLENCE WILL NOT HELP THEM BECOME SUCCESSFUL IN THEIR LIVES.
- TEACH THEM HOW TO TAKE A DEEP BREATH IN AND COUNT TO TEN TO HELP THEM TO THINK MORE CLEARLY ABOUT THE SITUATION.
- GIVE THEM COPING MECHANISMS THAT THEY CAN DO TO HELP THEM DEAL WITH THEIR FRUSTRATION SUCH AS;
- O READING A BOOK/DRAWING A PICTURE
- O GOING FOR A WALK
- $0 \quad \text{ANY PHYSICAL ACTIVITY} \\ \textbf{--} \text{RUNNING, CLEANING, CLIMBING} \\ \textbf{--} \text{JUST NOT PHYSICAL AGGRESSION}$
- O TAKE EVERY OPPORTUNITY TO BOOST EACH CHILD'S CONFIDENCE.
- O HAVE A DISCIPLINE PLAN READY FOR WHEN PROBLEMS ARISE.
- O Show your child how to resolve conflicts by talking with them through situations and listening to their points of view.
