Welcome to a new school year! If you haven't participated in Scrip in the past or if you've gotten out of the habit of doing Scrip, a new school year is a great time to begin. You are now able to order and pay online which will make your Scrip ordering experience even easier. There are also many retailers where you can place your order online, pay with PrestoPay and get your Scrip certificate immediately. You don't even have to wait for an order date.
