I am grateful to you for your compassionate response. May you be blessed for your faithfulness to living the Gospel and recognizing Jesus in those in need.

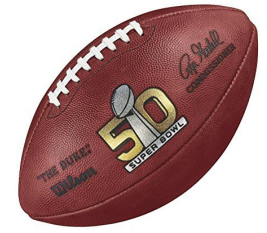

**Did you know?**

The Mass, especially the Liturgy of the Eucharist, is a Holy Meal. At the *Last Supper*, Jesus gathered with his apostles to celebrate the Passover. The Passover recalled the exodus of the Israelites out of Egypt. When it came time to say the customary prayers, Jesus did something dramatic. He took the bread and gave it to his apostles saying, "This is my body," and with the wine, he said, "This is my blood." The Mass as it is celebrated today can be traced back to this *Last Supper*. As the bread and wine are consecrated to become the body and blood of Jesus, a new Passover is celebrated—Jesus as the Lamb of God whose blood protects and frees us from sin and death. Just as food and drink nourish our bodies, the Eucharist nourishes our souls.

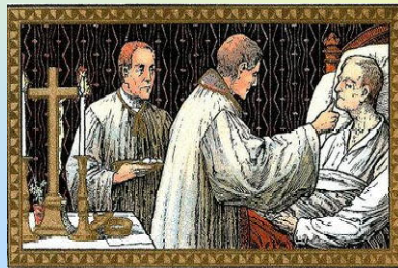
