INDIVIDUAL MATCH PLAY



Boundary Oaks Golf Course

1st round 32 Players ~ Jan 11
2nd round 16 Players ~ Feb 8
3rd round 8 Players ~ Mar 4
4th round 4 Players ~ Apr 11
Final round 2 Players ~ May 9

All participants must pay \$5.00 to the treasurer to enter this event.

Open to first 32 players to sign up. Any player who cannot play on the scheduled date must notify the Tournament Director, (dugganhu@sbglobal.net), in advance so the game can be rescheduled at a regular tournament, and must be played before the next round. If both team members cannot play a scheduled match, they must forfeit.

Format: Field of 32 players seeded by random draw in two man matches where one player competes against another. The lower net score wins the hole. The state of the match is expressed by the terms: so many “holes up” with so many “to play” or “all square.” The winner of the match advances to the next round of competition until the Champion is determined. Each participant play their own ball as in stroke play and post their individual score. All par 3 holes will be played from the gold tees.

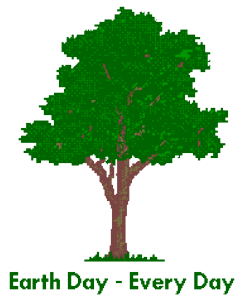

Two-Man Team Scramble

All participants must pay \$5.00 to the treasurer to enter this event.

Format: Two-man teams will consist of a higher-handicap and lower handicap player randomly selected by the Tournament Director. The teams handicap will be 50% of the sum of the teams total handicap. When each player on a side has teed off, they choose the best shot, and both players hits from there. This procedure is followed until the ball is holed. Awards will be determined for three place finishes. With this format, individual scores can not be posted nor will this tournament count in the Branch metal-play championships.

2016 Special Event Tournaments

Four-Man Team Par Point

Course as Scheduled
Tournament Director: Hugh Duggan



All participants must pay \$5.00 to the treasurer to enter this event.

Format: Each player in the foursome plays their own ball as in metal play, but scores are determined by a modified Stableford System of points. Double Eagle = +8, Eagle = +6, Birdie = +4, Par = +2, Bogie + 1, Double Bogie or worst = 0. Total of all balls count for teams score. In this game, high scores are good!



TWO-MAN TEAM MATCH PLAY

1st round 16 teams ~ Aug 15

2nd round 8 teams ~ Sep 12

3rd round 4 teams ~ Oct 10

Final round 2 teams ~ Nov 14

Tournament Director: Hugh Duggan

All participants must pay \$5.00 to the treasurer to enter this event.

Format: Two-man teams will be selected by random draw. This is a match in which two players play their better ball against the better ball of two other players. The lowest net score wins the hole. The state of the match is expressed by the terms: so many “holes up” with so many “to play,” or “all square.” The winning teams advance to the next round of competition until the Championship is determined. Each competitor plays their own ball and post their individual score as in metal play.

In case of a tie at the end of 18 holes, we will use a card off to determine the winner. The first tie breaker will be the team that won the most holes on the back nine. If still a tie, the team who won the last six holes. If still a tie, the team who won the last three holes. After that, we will flip a coin.

Any player who cannot play on the scheduled date must notify the Tournament Director, Hugh Duggan (dugganhu@sbglobal.net), in advance so the game can be rescheduled, and must be played before the next round. If both team members cannot play a scheduled match, they must forfeit.

Players must calculate the number of strokes allowed on each hole based upon their handicap for the course and tees they play. The teams score is the total of the low net “better” balls of the round.
