<u>RULES:</u> All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by contacting the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, by phone (919) 233-9767, by email at info@akc.org, or on their website at www.akc.org.

<u>SAFETY</u>, <u>BEHAVIOR</u> and <u>LIABILITY</u>: The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the club or any official thereof.

REFUNDS: No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

100% of entry fees will be refunded for any reason if a written (or email) request is received by the <u>TRIAL SECRETARY</u> on or before the trial closing. After closing, refunds less \$6.00 in fees/day will be given for bitches in season if written (or email) notification is received by the <u>TRIAL SECRETARY</u> prior to the start of the trial. Verification from a veterinarian may be required at the club's discretion.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not on official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement attached, cannot be accepted. Checks for entry fees will be deposited soon after the closing date. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry, and a processing fee will be added to all returned checks.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes** (except for move-ups as detailed on Page 3) after the trial closing. Prepare your entry form carefully, and double-check your preliminary confirmation. If you have questions about which class to enter, contact the Trial Secretary before the closing date.

ENTRY FEES: \$16.00 first entry (incl \$3.50 AKC recording fee) and \$16.00 each add'l entry, same dog/same day (incl \$3.00 AKC recording fee).

<u>ONLINE ENTRIES:</u> Go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Services home page at <u>www.akc.org/AgilityEntry</u> and follow the instructions there. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries per day designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 80 runs/day via online entries, 250 runs/day via paper entries. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials (available at www.akc.org).

<u>DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:</u> This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been enrolled with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

<u>CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY:</u> If the exhibitor provides an e-mail address, it is assumed that the exhibitor can receive e-mail with attachments from the Trial Secretary. A preliminary confirmation will be sent via email soon after your entry is received; please REVIEW IT CAREFULLY and notify the secretary of any necessary changes as soon as possible. Please make sure your spam blocker is set to accept messages from RedTileServices@gmail.com. If an email address is provided, a final confirmation of entry and schedule of judging will be sent via email after the closing date. If an e-mail address is not provided, confirmation of entry will be sent by USPS after closing (no preliminary confirmations will be sent). If an exhibitor has not received a confirmation and schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups as a result of titles earned after entries close must be submitted in writing or email so that the Trial Secretary receives them by 6:00 PM MDT on Monday April 9. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send to RedTileServices@gmail.com. If you do not receive a prompt acknowledgement of your move-up request, please contact the Trial Secretary to make sure that it was received. No phone move ups accepted. Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups for Saturday and Sunday must be submitted in

writing no later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the last class on Friday and Saturday.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for all qualifying scores and for first through fourth place in each height division in each class. A dog toy **or item** (offered by the club; value \$2.00-5.00) will be awarded to first place in each height division in each class. A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

All dogs earning their MACH or PACH titles at this trial will receive a trophy bar and ribbon! If you are close to earning an award, please let the **TRIAL CHAIR** know so your agility friends are prepared to celebrate with you.

SITE INFORMATION: Lolo Peak Arena, 16175 Hwy 12 W, Lolo, MT.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds (and at your motel)!

BUILDING HOURS: On Friday, the building will open for exhibitor setups starting at 12:30 PM (the club will be setting up the ring in the arena prior to the building opening for exhibitors). On Saturday and Sunday, the building will be open at 7:00 AM.

All dogs must be **on leash** at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area.

CAMPING: Limited dry camping (no hookups, porta-potties only) MAY be available at the trial site for \$5/night. Contact Rickie van Berkum (fhvb55@gmail.com) for information and reservations.

CONCESSIONS: A concession booth will be available at the trial site. Lunches will be provided to all volunteers who work at least two classes.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes <u>must</u> compete at the required jump height and <u>may not</u> compete in a jump height division <u>higher or lower</u> than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by *a* Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners** SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
