### **Philanthropy on Tap Proposal**

## **Overview**

Kern Community Foundation ("Foundation") believes that a healthy nonprofit sector is essential to the overall quality of life in our Kern community. The Foundation provides general support to nonprofit organizations in the Kern community primarily through grants from donor advised funds. Competitive grants are also awarded through the Foundation's grantmaking initiatives.

For this opportunity, the Foundation will only accept requests from organizations that have a current and reviewed profile on its Nonprofit Search database. Organizations previously showcased at Philanthropy on Tap will not be considered.

- 1. Where does Philanthropy on Tap take place?
  Philanthropy on Tap takes place at Imbibe Wine, 4140 Truxtun Avenue, in Bakersfield.
- 2. What is the capacity?

  The capacity is 50 people seated, 70 people seated and standing.
- How long is Philanthropy on Tap?
   Each even is around an hour. It begins at 5pm with check-in and mingling then ends at 6pm.
   Guests are welcome to stay and enjoy dinner at Imbibe.

  Philanthropy on Tap is always held on a Monday. The Foundation will coordinate with you and Imbibe to choose a satisfactory date for both.
