NEW Camp Format!

(Entering Grades 1 to 6 - Open to Non-Bedminster Residents)

Now in our 35th year, Camp Bedminster offers terrific and safe summer fun for children entering 1st through 6th grades! Camp Bedminster is a half day summer camp held in the Bedminster School from 8:30 am to 12 noon, Monday through Friday for seven (7) consecutive weeks beginning June 23 through August 8. **Before Care** is available for an additional fee beginning at 8 am. If you are looking for an extended day program, also offered separately is our **Lunch Bunch Program** which is a supervised "bring your own lunch"/recess program, followed by a variety of **week-long Afternoon Camps each running from 1 to 4 pm**. Camp Bedminster activities include simple Arts & Crafts, Sports, traditional Games, Discovery Sciences, and Musical activities. Additional activities include Camp Olympics, theme days, group skits, talent show, and field trips. Campers are divided into groups by grade and supervised by Counselors and Counselors-In-Training (CITs) with specialists teaching the main activity areas. You can choose either a three (3) day or five (5) day camp option. The 5-day option includes field trips which are scheduled on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The 3-Day option meets Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays only and the children do not attend the trips. Tuition assistance is available.

New this year we are offering three (3) sessions of Camp Bedminster in either the 3 or 5 day format OR you can choose the entire seven (7) week option (at a discount). This new format requires a great deal of coordination, therefore we are asking that you register early and on time as registration may not be available after June 6th. The options are as follows:

We have been busy over the winter planning our trips, activities, theme days and more for this camp season! The camp calendar is attached. Approximately a week before camp begins, parents will be mailed a camp orientation packet which will include:

- (1) Detailed Camp Bedminster Information & Rules,
- (2) Updated Camp Calendar,
- (3) Behavior Policy & Discipline
- (4) Individual Trip Waiver Forms, and
- (5) Windshield signs for easy pick-up.

Below are some important things to know about Camp Bedminster:

- <u>CAMP HOURS</u> The program runs from 8:30 am to 12 Noon daily. If you choose the 3-Day option, there is No Camp on Field Trip Days (Tuesdays & Thursdays). No camp on Friday, July 4th.
- <u>DROP-OFF/PICK-UP</u> Drop off is at 8:30 a.m. unless your child is registered for our *Before Care Program* (described below). "Curb-side" pick-up is at 12 noon daily. Parents are to park in the upper lot if they want to come in and pick up their child. Pick-up Notes are required if you child is going home with anyone other than a parent or guardian.
- <u>CAMP TRIPS</u> Children are provided with camp t-shirts on the first day of camp. Camp shirts must be worn on trip days for your child's identification and safety. Replacement shirts are available for \$5 each. On trip days, the <u>busses depart at 8:45 a.m. sharp</u>, so please drop your child off by 8:30 a.m. for attendance and last minute instructions. It is up to you if you would like to send your child with extra money (\$5 to \$10) for additional refreshments and games. The trip schedule is attached and subject to change. And remember . . . **No camp at school on field trip days!**
- <u>BEFORE CARE</u> Before Care is child supervision from 8 to 8:30 am, Monday through Friday before Camp Bedminster
 Starts. Camp Bedminster Director, Randy Backer, supervises the children and offers Before Care on a **PAY AS YOU GO**option on a day to day basis. Parents/Guardians pay Randy directly each day or by the week. <u>Fee:</u> \$2 per child per
 session payable directly to Randy Backer.
- <u>LUNCH BUNCH</u> The *Lunch Bunch* program serves as a "bridge" between Bedminster Recreation's morning and afternoon programs for the seven (7) weeks Camp Bedminster is in session. *Lunch Bunch* is only for those children who will be attending Camp Bedminster in the morning and participating in our afternoon camps, or for those parents looking for an extended day. Lunch Bunchers bring their own lunch from home and eat lunch together in the Bedminster School Cafetorium (or outside if weather permits), and then recess while being supervised by our Camp Director, Teachers, Counselors and CITs. After *Lunch Bunch*, counselors will then walk campers to their next camp location and check them in with the instructor (for camps held only at the school or Miller Lane Park). Registration for *Lunch Bunch* is by the week or discounted seven (7) week option, Monday thru Friday. Sorry no prorating available!
- ALLERGIES Please be sure to notify us of any allergies or medical conditions so that we may assist your child.
 Epi Pens require a special waiver.
- SPECIAL NEEDS ACCOMMODATIONS The Township of Bedminster welcomes everyone to participate in its programs and activities. If your child has individualized needs due to a disability (e.g. learning, medical, physical, psychiatric, speech & language disabilities, Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder, brain injury, etc.), please call the Bedminster Township Recreation Department on (908) 212-7014 and we will gladly arrange for reasonable accommodations for participation in our programs. A minimum of three (3) week notice is required to ensure that appropriate accommodations can be provided. Please call the Recreation Dept. as early as possible.
- <u>FIRST AID</u> Our Camp Director Randy Backer is a NJ licensed Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) and will be the first line of treatment. Additional members of our staff are trained in First Aid, CPR & AED.
- <u>TUITION ASSISTANCE</u> -Tuition Assistance is available for Bedminster Residents only. Please provide a copy of your current approved "Federal Lunch Program Eligibility" along with your registration to receive discount.

Register on-line with credit card at <u>www.bedminster.us</u> or return registration form with check payable to "Bedminster Recreation" by Friday, June 6th! After June 6th there is a \$20 late fee.
