Front Range Flu Shots Policies:

Note: Insurance card must be presented at time of service. Co-payments may apply.

SEASONAL FLU SHOT

Age Policy: Must be 4 years or older to receive a flu shot.

Accepted Insurance Plans: Medicare Part B or Railroad Medicare Part B (when primary insurance plan), AARP Medicare Complete/SecureHorizons, United HealthCare Medicare Solutions, Douglas County School District Cigna, Humana, Rocky Mountain Health Plans/CNIC (when primary insurance plan). Additional insurance carriers or networks may be accepted and co-payment may apply. Ask the nurse if your insurance or network is accepted.

SEASONAL FluMist NASAL SPRAY. Upon Availability. Must sign up in advance.

Age Policy: FluMist is available to healthy individuals ages 4 - 49 years who are not pregnant.

Accepted Insurance Plans: Douglas County School District Cigna, Humana, Rocky Mountain Health Plans/CNIC. Additional insurance carriers or networks may be accepted and co-payment may apply. Ask the nurse if your insurance or network is accepted.

A/California/7/2009 (H1N1)pdm09, the pandemic strain
an A/Victoria/361/2011 (H3N2)-like virus
