

Tips for Solo and Ensemble Festival Performance

The night before the festival:

Decide what to wear. This is a special day, and **you should plan to dress up.**


Invite relatives to attend your performance. Be sure to tell them what time you sing and what room. Remind them that there will be many students performing in different rooms, so it is important to keep those performance areas quiet (especially the hallways).

At the festival:

- Arrive at least 20 minutes before your performance to warm up your voice.
- Locate the site of your performance and check in with the room monitor and check the schedule. Is your room running ahead or behind?
- Find a room and warm-up.

Right before you perform:

- Arrive 10 minutes early (just in case they are running ahead!)
- Position yourself so the adjudicator can see you.
- Breathe!
- Smile and begin your introduction
- This is your opportunity to show everyone what you are able to do. Let any mistakes go by, and enjoy the opportunity of being able to make music!
- After the performance, listen to the judge's comments and feedback.
- Listen and enjoy your friend's performances.



Dear Current 4th-7th Grade Families,

It is hard to believe that another school year is over half completed. We all know that time really begins to fly when this part of the school year arrives. Knowing this, it is time to begin making plans for the 2016-17 school year.

Students in grades 5-8 select what Music Ensemble they wish to participate in. Students have the opportunity to choose to be in Band and Choir, only Band, or only Choir. Students will all receive the same amount of study hall time at the end of the school day, no matter if they are in one performance ensemble or two.

In order to help the KCSS Music staff plan and prepare for the upcoming school year, we are asking current 5th through 7th grade students to register for what Music Ensemble they are interested in being a part of for the next school year. Students are required to be a part of at least one Music Ensemble at KCSS.

In this letter, you will find course descriptions and expectations for Band and Choir. Select which ensemble(s) would be a good fit for your KCSS student. 4th Grade Families, please also consult the Band Packet that Miss Glielmi has sent home with students to learn more about Band.

Welcome to Band! (Grades 5-8)

What to look forward to...

Band is a class that focuses on performance, working together as a team and working on our musical abilities. Each band meets twice a week and performs two concerts per year (Christmas and spring). Students will also be required to learn one solo and/or ensemble as a graded requirement. This year we excited to be hosting a Solo/Ensemble Event at Holy Cross! Participation in the festival is required by all 6th-8th grade band students (optional for 5th grade). Students will be performing their solo and/or ensemble for the class during the spring semester before the Solo/Ensemble event.

Instruction for Band will include:

- Large group rehearsal
- Private lessons once a week (6th-8th) Group lessons for 5th grade
- ▶ Rehearsals in small groups and/or sectionals
- *The band depends on individual practice to learn the required music.

Materials Required:

- Instrument: In good working condition (with swab, reeds, valve oil etc.)
- 2 Pencils (sharpened)
- Standard of Excellence Lesson Book (provided by the school)
- ▶ Black Band Folder (provided by the school)
- ▶ Band music (provided by the school)
- *Students are responsible for replacing lost or damaged music at a cost of approximately \$5.00 \$10.00 per piece.

Expectations/Grading:

- Concerts attending with instrument and music; and also demonstrating proper performance/audience etiquette.
- Classroom participation being on time with required materials and being respectful to the rest of the class.
- Lessons (Group or individual) being on time with instrument, book and practice chart; listening to instruction and being responsible for all materials covered.
- Written Work/Homework: practicing and filling out a practice chart on time and/or any other work that is assigned in class.

Extra Credit may include:

- Church performances
- Practicing more than required each week
- Helping Miss Glielmi in her office
- Attending a concert (outside KCSS) with a review
- Participation in small ensembles or other performance opportunities outside KCSS
- Participation in Solo and Ensemble Festival (5th grade only)



Welcome to Choir (Grades 5-8)!

The goal for this class is to use the gifts and talents that God has given us to minister to our school, church, and community by using our voices in song.

Choir is a class that focuses on performance and working together as a team. Choir is also a time where students can explore all of the amazing things the human voice can do. Students learn proper vocal technique and how to care for their voice.

The Choir will perform in two concerts per year: one in December and the other in late April/early May. Students are also required to perform a Solo/Ensemble piece in the spring. The festival takes place at Holy Cross School. Once a date has been set, information will be distributed to students and families.

Instruction for Choir will include: group rehearsal, small group rehearsals, small group/individual lessons, and individual practice outside of school. The Choir's success depends on each and every student learning their part and taking rehearsal time seriously.

Choir Expectations

- Arrive to all rehearsals and events on time
- Treat fellow choir members and director with respect
- Complete and turn in assignments or other materials on time
- Be responsible with materials and music that is distributed
 - ✓ If music or materials is lost or damaged, a fine of the value of the lost/damaged item will be charged (approximately \$1.50 \$2.50 per piece)
- Positive Attitude
- Attend all required Concerts and Events

Grading

Grades in Choir will be based on the following criteria: attitude, participation, growth in individual musical skills and abilities, completion of assignments and practice journals, and attendance at rehearsals, lessons, Liturgy Choir, Concerts, and Solo/Ensemble.

- Students will have the opportunity to earn daily Participation Points based on the following behaviors: Attitude, Participation, Respectfulness, and Preparedness.
- Students will be assessed on implementing the new musical skills they are learning during Choir rehearsals.
- Students are required to attend two 15 minute individual/small group lessons per quarter. Sectional rehearsals will be used on an as needed basis. This will take place if more than the regular scheduled rehearsal time is needed.
- ♪ Students will be required to complete a weekly practice journal or assignment.
- ▶ Students will be the Liturgy Choir for a School Liturgy planned by 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th grade classes.
- Students may have written work, homework, tests, or quizzes taken on musical terms or concepts.
