### Junior Division Camping and Parking Rules for 2015 Fair

- 1. Only 1 camper, camp trailer or tent per space.
- 2. Camper, camp trailer or tents are to be placed/parked in the designated area only.

- 3. Livestock trailers will be parked in the designated trailer parking area. No livestock trailers in camping area.
- 4. Campers must be in place by 8pm Monday, August 3 and remain in place for the duration of the Fair unless designated above as a Horse participant only. During the animal check-in hours, access to the campers will be restricted. This will allow the livestock trailers to access their check-in areas without excessive congestion.
- 5. There is NO car or pick-up parking in the camping area after Tuesday, August 5.
- 6. Campers, camp trailer or tents may be brought to the Fairgrounds after 3:00 p.m. on Friday, July 31, 2015 and must be in place by 8 p.m. Monday, August 3, 2015. Access to the designated camping space may be temporarily blocked after Friday due to ongoing events.
- 7. Removal of campers, camp trailers and tents the final Sunday of Fair must be done prior to 10am or after 6pm. All other campers, camp trailers or tents must be removed by noon the Monday after Fair.
- 8. Only Gate E on the east side of the Fairgrounds will be used for car/pickup access to the camping area on a temporary basis for a limited amount of time. All occupants of the vehicle must have a 4H ID card or family wristband.
- 9. The road around the Fairgrounds cannot be blocked at any time during the Fair. Access is to be maintained as the Fire Lane.
- 10. The Fair Management will issue designated camping permits once the camping sites are assigned after registration.
- 11. The designated camping permit will be required to be displayed in the window of all campers/camp trailers at all times during the Fair.
- 12. All campers, camp trailers and tents shall be self-contained. No electric or water hook up available.
- 13. REMINDER: Alcohol is permitted in the campers for adult consumption only. Coolers must be secured at all times. Additionally, alcohol will be sold in designated areas on the Fairgrounds during County Fair. Otherwise, alcohol cannot be consumed or carried anywhere else on the grounds.
- 14. Camper Code of Conduct will be enforced as follows:
  - A. Conduct themselves in a courteous, respectful manner; using appropriate language, exhibiting good sportsmanship and providing positive role models.
  - B. Adhering to program regulations & requirements, curfews, dress codes, policies and guidelines;

- C. Comply with designated QUIET TIMES: Midnight to 5am daily. No Generators running during this time.
- D. Abstaining from illegal and immoral behavior;
- E. Fully participating in scheduled activities;
- F. Refraining from physical or emotional child abuse or neglect;
- G. Applying regulations of safety to individuals, groups and property; and
- H. Accepting personal responsibility for behavior.

Consequences may include penalties as set forth in Section V of the Douglas County Fair & Rodeo General Competition Requirements & Regulations.

- 15. Each camping/ trailer/ motor home / tent must have a designated Parent/Guardian OR Adult (21 years of age or older) that must stay overnight and responsible for the minors staying in camper.
- 16. Each camper is responsible to know and abide by ALL of the requirements and regulations listed in the 2015 Douglas County Fair and Rodeo Competition Requirements & Regulations, including but not limited to:
  - A. Personal golf carts, ATV's and bicycles will not be allowed on the Fairgrounds during County Fair.
  - B. Dogs are not allowed on the Fairgrounds during the Douglas County Fair & Rodeo with the following exceptions:
    - 1) Service Animals
    - 2) Dogs on leashes will be allowed in the camping and trailer parking areas only. For their safety, dogs should not be tethered to a camper. A self-contained kennel is required for dogs staying in the camping area.
    - Excessive barking or complaints of aggressive behavior will result in the dog being excused from the Douglas County Fairgrounds. Excused dogs must be immediately removed from the Douglas County Fairgrounds.
    - 4) Dogs that are competing or performing during the Douglas County Fair & Rodeo.
    - 5) Owners / Handlers must keep dogs under constant control and dogs ARE NOT allowed into any livestock barns, Kirk Hall, or the Events Center.
  - C. Sleeping in Livestock and Horse Barns is Strictly Forbidden.
  - D. Fireworks are NOT allowed.
