*About our speaker:*

**Brenda Eaton** has a Masters Degree in Education and has worked at the Chester County Intermediate Unit for 10 years in the field of autism. She has obtained a certification in Autism and Applied Behavior Analysis and is a Board Certified Behavior Analyst. She coordinates various programs such as a diagnostic program, social groups for teens and adults and does college coaching for transitioning adolescents with an Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). Brenda is also the parent of a 17 year old with an ASD diagnosis.

*About the presentation:*

The presentation will provide the current rate of autism, diagnostic criteria info, epidemiology, levels within the Autism Spectrum and will provide strategies and interventions that can be used.

**Directions to Community Volunteers in Medicine (CVIM)  
300 B Lawrence Drive, West Chester, Pa 19380**

**Coming from Delaware County:**

Take Route 3 to Five Points Road (traffic light before you get into town of West Chester). Turn right onto Five Points Road. Continue straight and cross Paoli Pike and Fern Hill Rd. (both have traffic lights). When you cross Fern Hill, you will see Ice Line on your right. Continue straight until you see a right turn onto Lawrence Dr. (Turn right onto Lawrence, and the building before Ice Line is CVIM. Parking is in front of building.

**Coming from Route 100 (High Street in West Chester):**

If you're coming from Route 100 south, turn left onto Market Street. (Center of West Chester) Continue straight until the road forks, and you'll see a sign for Paoli Pike on your left. Take that fork and stay on Paoli Pike past the West Goshen shopping center. Go to Five Points Rd. (traffic light) and turn left. Follow Five Points Rd. crossing over Fern Hill Rd. (traffic light). When you cross Fern Hill Rd. you'll see Ice Line on your right. Continue straight until you see a right turn onto Lawrence Dr. Turn right onto Lawrence Dr. the building before Ice Line is CVIM. Parking is in front of building.
