The Confirmation Sponsor must be a confirmed, practicing Catholic. It cannot be a parent; however, the sponsor can be a grandparent or Godparent. This should be someone the candidate trusts in seeking out faith advice and direction. While the popular choice is a family member or family friend, we also recommend small group leaders and ministry leaders. But, this is a choice up to the candidate. Recommend that the sponsor only sponsor one candidate.

- I understand that as a sponsor I am to live a life in harmony with the nature of this responsibility, meaning, for example, that I regularly attend Mass.
- I receive the Eucharist regularly; I make use of the sacrament of Reconciliation.
- I am not married outside the church, cohabitating, or in an otherwise irregular situation.
- I seek to the best of my understanding of my Catholic faith to be faithful to the teachings of the Church.
- I attest that I have received the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, and that I am at least 16 years old. (preferably eighteen)
- I also understand that being a sponsor is a commitment of time.
- I (or my designated proxy) will attend required events and the sacramental celebration.
- I further understand that being chosen as a sponsor is a lifetime commitment to be, as I am able, a faithful witness of the Catholic way of life to the individual I am called to serve.
- I will obtain a Certificate of Good Standing from my parish.
- I attend Mass regularly on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, follow the precepts of the Church, and possess no impediments for serving as a sponsor.
- I am not a parent of the individual to be confirmed.

節 Be at least sixteen years of age (preferably eighteen);

簕 Not be a parent of the individual to be confirmed.

## **REHEARSAL**

\* The rehearsal is scheduled in the Wooldridge Center/Church on Sunday, January 25, 1:00 p.m. after the noon mass.

\* Candidate and sponsor (or if sponsor cannot attend, at least one parent) MUST attend.

\* Please be thoughtful of others and plan on arriving at the Wooldridge Center no later than 1:00p.m., so that we can begin promptly at 1:15p.m..

\* Rehearsal should not last any longer than one hour. We will try to be as efficient as possible, and will try to wrap up early if possible.

### **CEREMONY**

\* Bishop Finn will preside at the confirmation ceremony.

\* Sponsors and candidates should <u>arrive at the Wooldridge Center no later than 6:20 pm</u> so there is sufficient time to check in, receive their name tags and line up and recollect.

\* The Rite is celebrated within Holy Mass. The ceremony will be long, so be prepared.

\* There is **no reserved seating for family members/guests**, only for candidates and sponsors.

\* PLEASE RECALL AND REMIND YOUR GUESTS THAT WHILE WE ARE IN THE CHURCH (whether before Mass, during, or as we prepare for photographs) WE ARE IN A SACRED SPACE. The occasion of such an important celebration often carries us away, but we need to be mindful and respectful of the Lord present, the place, and others present as well.

- Dress slacks
- Dress shoes with socks
- Dress shirt, tucked in, with collar
- Tie is preferred, but optional
- NO JEANS, NO SNEAKERS, NO T-SHIRTS
- \* <u>Girls</u>:
  - Dress, skirt and blouse, nice pants suit/outfit.
  - Dress shoes (no flip-flops)
  - Dress/skirt must be to your knee or longer. NO SHORT SKIRTS.
  - Tops/dresses must have sleeves. No spaghetti straps. IF YOU WEAR A SLEEVELESS DRESS OR BLOUSE, YOU MUST WEAR A SWEATER/JACKET OVER IT, BEFORE and AFTER CEREMONY
  - No necklines that show cleavage are to be worn
- \* If in doubt, don't wear it. We will send a candidate home to change if he/she is dressed inappropriately.
