First Annual “Chair-ity” Auction

Artists and Designers are needed to create constructed, altered, and/or embellished chairs for our first annual Chair-ity Auction. As suggested by her mom, the auction will benefit the Duke Pediatric Bone Marrow Transplant Family Support Team in honor of Lexi Rucker. This will be an online auction, with chairs being displayed at a minimum of three locations prior to the auction. The committee is looking for individuals and/or businesses to design and enter a chair to be auctioned off. The chair can be rocking chairs, kitchen chairs, children’s chairs, computer chairs, recliners, car seats, bar stools, etc.

Chair Guidelines:

- Registrations must be received by Friday, November 6th, 2015.
- Any form of seating may be used (stools, chairs, lawn furniture, bean-bags, etc.) Use your imagination!
- The seating, itself, may be a work of art or may be a fun “themed” chair. They may also be accessorized accordingly. For example.... A kitchen chair could have a cookbook. A rocking chair could have an afghan or family photo album. This is optional, not required.
- The important thing is that each be unique, creative, and desirable.
- Please do not include perishable items or items that cannot be incorporated as part of the chair display.
- Judges will vote on the entries and awards will be presented. There will be three awards given for chairs- “Most Original”, “Lexi’s Choice” and “Chair of the Year”.
- Page County High School FCCLA reserves the right not to display any entry that is deemed inappropriate, offensive, unsafe, of unacceptable quality.
- Chairs are due to PCHS FCCLA by Wednesday, November 18th. The online auction will open on Friday, November 20th.
- A reception will be held for all artists on Monday, December 7th at Page County High School.
- Placement, positioning, and starting bids are determined by PCHS FCCLA.
- Upon delivery of your chair, please be prepared to give the approximate retail value of the chair and any items that are included in the display.
- Pinterest and the internet are a great way to search for ideas! Just type in “Chair-ity Fundraiser” and see what comes up! Shop for bargain chairs to be repurposed at thrift stores or yard sales.
