#### CHMM Recertification Standards Updated.

IHMM announced that the recertification standards for the CHMM credential have been revised. The clarification is necessary to prepare for accreditation by ANSI under ISO standard 17024.

As part of the revision, the recertification cycles have been adjusted to conform more closely to certification anniversary dates. The Certification Maintenance Point (CMP) schedule for reporting professional development activities has been revised.
