Rules Governing the Award and Use of R.T.B.A. Scholarship For Residents of The Ridley School District

1. ELIGIBILITY – Any High School Senior residing in The Ridley School District, and whose parents or guardian has been a resident of The Ridley School District for two years.

The applicant's High School average must be 80% or better. (A transcript of applicants high School records must accompany application.)

- 2. SELECTION The Scholarship Committee shall choose candidates on the basis of overall merit.
- 3. FROM THE CANDIDATES chosen in the preliminary selection the committee will choose winners and alternates, grading the alternates first and second on each scholarship.
- 4. ALTERNATES An alternate, in his or her numerical order, will take the place of any winner who declines the scholarship, or who does not fully comply with the provisions of these rules.

Any alternate who may acquire the right to a scholarship will be subject to the rules which apply to the winning candidate including the provisions contained in Rule 6. The exception is made, however, in respect to entering school in the fall that an alternate who may be notified of appointment too late to gain admission at the beginning of the fall term will be given a reasonable time to enter school.

- 5. The school must agree to refund (pro rata) any unused balance of the scholarship award, in the event the applicant does not complete one full semester.
- 6. OBLIGATION OF WINNERS Within 10 days following notification of selection, a winner must notify the R.T.B.A. in writing of his or her acceptance of the scholarship. Within 30 days of notification of selection or sooner, if possible, a winner must submit evidence in writing of his or her acceptance by a recognized college, university, or vo-tec school. Winner must also attend the R.T.B.A. Scholarship Banquet the 4th Tuesday in June.

In the event of failure of a winning candidate to meet the obligations outlined in these rules, or failure to enter college at the beginning of the term following the award of the R.T.B.A. Scholarship, the R.T.B.A. Scholarship Committee reserves the right to withdraw the candidate's Scholarship benefits.

7. OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS – It shall be the duty of every Scholarship winner to report promptly in writing to the R.T.B.A. on the acceptance or use of any other scholarship aid or grant. The Scholarship Committee will consider all the facts and circumstances and

reserves the right to determine whether or not any benefits of the R.T.B.A. Scholarship shall be withheld or withdrawn.

Failure of any R.T.B.A. Scholar to report promptly in writing on acceptance or use of any other full or partial scholarship or grant shall be cause for withdrawal of all further R.T.B.A. benefits.

- 8. COURSES Winners of the Scholarships may choose any college, university or vo-tech school of recognized standing.
- 9. PAYMENTS OF SCHOLARSHIP The R.T.B.A. will make remittance directly to the student. *Note
- 10. ACADEMIC STANDING The continuing benefits of the R.T.B.A. Scholarship shall be dependent upon the student maintaining continuous attendance as will as scholastic and behavior standings satisfactory to the school authorities. In case prolonged illness or hardship prevents continuous attendance, the student's unused scholarship rights may be reinstated if, in the sole judgment of the Scholarship Committee, the circumstances so warrant. In case a school suspends or expels an R.T.B.A. Scholar, the Scholarship Committee reserves the right to withdraw all further scholarship benefits.
- 11. CHANGING SCHOOL there will be no restrictions as to a scholar's changing school before graduation, provided the transfer is approved by the authorities of both schools.
- 12. MILITARY SERVICE If in time of war or in connection with any compulsory military training program, a R.T.B.A. Scholar enters the Armed Services of the United States, or is unable to enter or remain in school because of obligatory service in war industry, the unused scholarship rights may be resumed if the student returns to college as an R.T.B.A. Scholar not later than the opening of the college term next following the date of discharge from the Armed Services, or release from obligatory service in war industry. To take advantage of this provision, an R.T.B.A. Scholar must inform the R.T.B.A. in writing upon entering any such service, and again within 30 days of discharge from military service or release from obligatory service in war industry. The resumption of unused scholarship benefits as outlined above will be limited to a five-year period from the date of induction into military service or obligatory service in war industry.

*Note: Remittance will be made upon receipt, in writing, of an invoice to a recognized college or university.
